USEED (Unity Socio-scientific Educational and Entrepreneurial Development) Research grant is a new initiative instituted by Research Advisory Council and Research Development Cell of KAHM Unity Women's College with the support of the College Governing Body and IQAC. This new initiative is a testament of the attitude of the college since it recognizes the significance of research and development in addressing societal challenges and fostering innovation. The primary objective is to create a platform for faculty members to develop high-value projects eligible for external funding from national and international agencies. To encourage faculty research, the college has established the Seed Money Research Project, inspired by the University's Seed Money Scheme (SMS) initiated in 2017.

The Seed Money Research Project aims to:

- ➤ Enhance faculty research capabilities for generating proposals for government and private-funded projects.
- ➤ Motivate faculty members to engage in research activities.
- > Generate innovative research ideas with an interdisciplinary approach
- ➤ Develop enhanced research culture among faculty members
- > Improve research output and publications.
- Create research projects addressing societal challenges.

Eligibility: Assistant and Associate Professors with a Ph.D. or MD/MS/DNB/MDS degree, having completed their probation period.

Faculty members can receive seed project financial support once during their tenure as Principal Investigator (PI).

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- ➤ Interdisciplinary projects allow for Co-PIs.
- Maximum project duration: two years, with possible extensions.
- > Grant amount: up to Rs 2 Lakh, based on proposal merit and committee decision.
- ➤ Expert guidance from Professors, Distinguished Professors, Professor Emeritus, and Visiting Professors as Mentors.
- ➤ Timely submission of utilization certificates to Dean Research and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC).
- Periodic progress review by Dean Research, with reports to Vice Chancellor and IQAC.
- > Final report submission in prescribed format after project completion.

In short Seed Money Research Project envisioned by the College fosters a research-oriented environment, encouraging faculty members to explore innovative ideas and develop high-value projects. ASSESSMENT NUTRITIONAL STATUS AMONG THE COLLEGE GOING SPORTS PERSONS

INTRODUCTION

Globally sports and athletics receive tremendous attention today. The sports industry is growing by leaps and bounds. India is making rapid strides in the field of sports and Indian athletes are endeavoring to reach the top position in national and international arena. Their performance is often obstructed by lack of stamina and poor health due to nutritional deficiencies and disorders. Moreover, lack of grass root level sports and training, poor stature, sub optimal diet, poor knowledge and understanding about sports nutrition are the causes of poor performance.

Adequate nutrition can enhance the performance of the sportsperson. Majority of the sportsperson knew that proper fueling can be obtained only by the proper nutrition and in addition to the adequate nutrition knowledge which can be an essential and integral part of a training program However, most of the sportsperson remain poorly educated about healthy nutritional practices and untrained in making appropriate daily nutritional choices. Several other factors might be poor understanding of sports nutrition principles, failure to recognize the specific nutritional requirements, an apparent conflict of nutrition goals, lack of practical nutrition knowledge and skills and overcommitted lifestyle, inadequate time and opportunities to obtain or consume appropriate foods.

NEED OF THE STUDY:

India has a rich heritage of sports and is home to a diverse population playing different sports across the country. It stretched to the seams by its burgeoning youth population. The youth comprise 27.5% and represent the most dynamic segment of the citizens (Census, 2011). As there is not much information on understanding the nutritional status and sports nutritional knowledge, attitude and practice of college sports persons in Kerala, the present study aims to analyze and compare the same between male and female college sportspersons in Kerala especially in Malappuram district. Athletes are not aware about sports nutrition. The more the knowledge the athletes acquire, the food choices also will be better. Adequate fluid intake and maintaining hydration status throughout practice and competition is often neglected by adolescent athletes, which increases the chances of dehydration.

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
