About the College

Korambayil Ahamed Haji Memorial Unity Women's College was established in 1991 and is run by Muslim Educational and Cultural Association (MECA) – a registered society. A First Grade Aided College affiliated to the University of Calicut, it is the first multi-faculty (Arts, Science & Commerce) Women's College in Malappuram District. It has also the unique distinction of being the only institution of this kind run by Muslim Community in Kerala. The institution aims the upliftment of women in general and the educationally backward Muslim women in particular, through modern good quality education. The College has creditable academic as well as co-curricular accomplishments. The college has been re-accredited in 2019 by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) at B++ Grade with CGPA 2.77

About the Department

The Department of Botany was established in 1995, with the introduction of B.Sc. Botany course as the fifth undergraduate programme in the college during 1995-'96. It has the privilege of being the first B.Sc. Botany course in the whole of Malappuram district. The course was officially inaugurated by Jb. E.T. Muhammed Basheer, the then Hon. Minister for education, Govt. of Kerala on 21-01-1996. The course was started with 18 students only and now the intake capacity is raised to the statutory maximum of 50 students. During 2013-14 M.Sc. Botany programme was introduced in unaided stream with an intake capacity of 12 students and during 2020-'21, we got sanction to a second batch of M.Sc. Botany in aided stream with an intake of 10 students. At present, the intake capacity is raised to a total of 40 in both streams, 20 in aided and 20 in unaided stream respectively.

Presently, the Department consists of 10 teaching staff and 2 non-teaching staff. The department is offering high quality education in plant science, in order that the students are able to engage meaningfully in activities requiring botanical expertise. The training given by the department provides knowledge and a comprehensive appreciation of plants at the organism, community and ecosystem level. So far 26 U.G and 9 P.G batches had passed out from the department with excellent academic achievements. By 2010-'11 academic year, 14 B.Sc. batches completed in the annual stream and we produced 12 University Ranks in B.Sc. Botany. From 2004 to 2011, the department claims the unique position of producing university ranks consecutively for 8 years out of 30 colleges offering B.Sc. Botany course in the University of Calicut during that time. Similarly, our Department bagged 1st and 8th ranks in MSc. Botany of 2017-19 P.G. batch. Recently, Department bagged 2nd and 10th ranks in MSc. Botany of 2022-24 P.G. batch. University of Calicut introduced Choice based Credit Semester system from 2009 U.G admission onwards and Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP) system starting from the 2024 undergraduate admissions. This system is aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, which aims to provide a more flexible, multidisciplinary, and holistic approach to higher education in India. Along with academic activities, faculty members are actively involved in research and extension activities.
