### 1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution:

- The College is frequently conducting seminars/workshops and awareness classes on relevant issues mainly aiming the students to sensitise them with latest developments that are taking place.
- For getting equal opportunities in the job sectors, the college has introduced coaching classes for minority students.
- Certain courses offered at PG level viz. MA English, UG level, B.Sc. Family & Community Science and B.Com Computer Application are having added relevant in the emerging employment scenario.

## 2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG):

Three UGC-aided **Add-on courses** are offered by the college.

The College has applied for M.Sc. Nutrition & Dietetics & M.Com.

The University has been recommended to the State Govt. to sanction the courses.

Dr.C.Abdul Majeed, HoD of Commerce, Dr.K.Azeez, HoD of Botany and Mrs. Jyothi.P., Department of Chemistry are members of UG Board of Studies, University of Calicut. They made their own contributions particularly in this field. The syllabi for B.Com Computer Applications and add-on courses were framed by the concerned departments.

There are provision for interdisciplinary programme in Choice based credit semester system to be introduced w.e.f. the academic year: 2009-'10.

- Environment Awareness Campaign sponsored by Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India was jointly conducted by departments of Zoology and Botany form 28<sup>th</sup> January to 6<sup>th</sup> February 2009.
- College has organized a talk on "Minority Politics in Secular India" on 7<sup>th</sup> August 2008. On the same day an Inter Collegiate Elocution competition was held.

The college has adopted a soft ware called OPAC (Online Public Access

Catalogue) which will locate the documents available in the library very quickly.

Through Network Resource Centre access to Internet facility is assured both for teachers and students. Computer Science Department offers Degree programme and UGC-aided Add-on course in Computer. The Computer Science Dept. is having internet facility for students.

Total 214 students are availing financial assistance in different forms such as Government scholarships, Post metric scholarships, University merit scholarship, Muslim girls scholarship, Students Aid Fund and fee concessions.

Being a younger women's college, Alumni support is nominal.

#### 31. Support from the Parent-Teacher Association and its activities:

For the growth and developmental activities of the college the wholehearted support of Parent-Teacher Association is vital. The transport facility to the college is partially supported by PTA. It also institute awards and cash prizes to the University rank holders and class toppers. Special prizes are also given to the students for their outstanding performance in sports and games competitions.

Mr.Zakir Ahamed P HoD, Physical Education was the Team Manager of the Malappuram District Badminton Team. He was also a Board member of K.P.S.C of the selection committee for Police constables..

College provides boarding facility and playing kits for the deserving sportspersons. PTA has also instituted a special prize for outstanding performers.
