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Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Action Taken Report 2022-2023

KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri

Introduction

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, continued its endeavors to ensure quality sustenance and enhancement during the academic year 2022-2023. Focusing on curricular aspects, IQAC collected stakeholder feedback and implemented interventions through faculty members, resulting in significant improvements.

Curricular Aspects and Interventions

IQAC collected feedback from stakeholders and facilitated necessary interventions through Board of Studies and Academic Council members in the University of Calicut. Key initiatives included:

- 1. Employability Skill Programme: 36-hour training for 439 students in association with Mahindra Pride Classroom.
- 2. Add-on Courses and Certificate Programs: Introduced 60 new courses to enhance student employability.
- 3. Online Courses: Promoted SWAYAM and NPTEL platforms, equipping a student resource group for SWAYAM courses.
- 4. Job Fair: Conducted to boost placements.
- 5. Moodle Platform: Implemented for advanced and technology-enabled learning and evaluation.
- 6. Teacher Training: Provided training on Moodle for all faculty members.
- 7. IPR Workshop: Conducted for students.
- 8. ERP Solution: Implemented a well-equipped Enterprise Resource Planning system.
- 9. E-Content Development: Conducted workshops for all faculty members.
- 10. Student Leadership and Support: Introduced 29 new clubs and cells.
- 11. Flash Talk Platform: Launched under the Hone Your Leadership Club to address cross-cutting issues.

Outcomes and Impact

- Enhanced employability skills for 439 students
- Increased course offerings by 60%

- Improved online learning resources
- Boosted placement opportunities
- Equipped faculty with Moodle and e-content development skills
- Fostered student leadership and support
- Addressed cross-cutting issues through Flash Talk platform

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2022-2023

DEPARTMENT OF BOTANY

World Environment Day – "Go Green: Planting a Sapling"

World Environment Day was celebrated on 6th June 2022. Dr. Deepa P. served as the faculty coordinator. The programme was titled "Go Green: Planting a Sapling."

Mushroom Cultivation – A Path Towards Self-Reliance for Students

Mushroom cultivation is an avenue for self-employment through the establishment of mushroom enterprises. The cultivation is managed by the PG Department of Botany, and a one-day market was organised at Unity Women's College, Manjeri, on 9th June 2022. The PG and UG students of the Department of Botany successfully cultivated mushrooms as part of their 'Earning Through Learning' programme, generating a profit.

Field Trips for M.Sc Students

A visit was organised to the Indian Institute of Spices Research (IISR) and the mangroves of Kadalundi Vallikkunnu Community Reserve (KVCR) on 22nd June 2022. Additionally, an algal collection and a visit to MBCHIPS, Kozhikode, were conducted for the first-year PG students on 10th March 2022. The aim of the research station visit to ICAR was to familiarise the students with various research techniques in Plant Pathology, Molecular Biology, and Biotechnology. The field trip to KVCR was intended to observe mangrove conservation efforts and understand the importance of conserving ecologically sensitive sites. Students also had the opportunity to study the wildlife and ecology of the area, and observe conservation measures taken by the authorities.

CSIR Life Science Coaching Classes

Coaching classes for upcoming competitive exams, such as CSIR, ICMR, ICAR, KSCSTE, and others, were initiated by the PG Department of Botany on 18th July 2022. The classes are scheduled for one hour on working days, with full-day sessions on holidays.

Publication of Research Papers

Faculty members and PG students published research papers in national and international journals during the academic year 2022-2023. Additionally, two ISBN books authored by faculty members were published.

Certificate Courses

Several certificate courses were offered during the academic year 2022-2023:

- Certificate Course on Cryptogam Diversity: This course introduced the concepts of lower plant groups, particularly cryptogams. Students explored the morphology and anatomy of major groups like algae, bryophytes, and pteridophytes, focusing on their life cycles.
- Applied Biostatistics: This course aimed to create awareness about biostatistics in plant science. It helped students critically evaluate research studies and assess evidence using

- statistical methods. Hands-on experience was provided in analysing and interpreting real-world health data, including clinical trials and epidemiological studies.
- *Pollination Biology*: This course focused on the scope and importance of pollination biology and palynology. Students observed various types of pollinators and learned to differentiate pollen grains based on morphology.
- *Crop Protection and Management*: This course aimed to familiarise students with organisms and causal factors responsible for plant diseases. Students also studied the host-parasite interaction process in plant diseases and learned methods to manage plant health.

Vegetable Garden Maintenance

A project-based vegetable cultivation initiative was organised in collaboration with the Agriculture Development and Farmers Welfare Department, Pulpatta Krishi Bhavan, and Pulpatta Grama Panchayath. Major vegetables cultivated included Baji Mulaku, Brinjal, Tomato, Kanthari Mulaku, Lady's Finger, Cauliflower, and Green Chillies. Dr. Usman A. was the faculty coordinator for this initiative.

Field Trips

- First-year UG students visited the ICAR-Indian Institute of Spices Research, Calicut, on 13th January 2022.
- A field trip to Wayanad was conducted on 14th January 2022 for first-year UG students.
- A nature camp was organised at Attappadi Hills, Palakkad, for second-year UG students on 1st and 2nd April 2022.
- A field study trip was conducted to Ramakkalmedu, Munnar, and Ernakulam for third-year UG students from 17th to 20th February 2022.

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2022-2023) DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

Poster Making Competition – International Day Against Drug Abuse

The Department of Psychology conducted a collage-making competition on 26th June 2022 in connection with International Day Against Drug Abuse for the college students. The objective was to promote a drug-free campus by enforcing a total ban on the consumption or use of drugs and alcohol among students. The first prize was secured by the students of the First Year BA English.

Certificate Course on Learning Disabilities

The objective of the course was to understand learning disabilities and developmental disabilities, learn how the brain is connected with learning, understand the diagnosis and assessment, and provide remedial programmes for learning disabilities. The course provided a clear understanding of the characteristics, causes, prevalence, and approaches to the evaluation of learning disabilities and other disorders in children.

Certificate Course on Self-Development Practicals

The course aimed to develop a personal vision, understand stress-reduction strategies, and build self-confidence and self-respect. It helped participants assess their skills and qualities, consider their life goals, and set objectives to realise and maximise their potential. The course also focused on enhancing employability, raising confidence, and leading a more fulfilling life. It enabled participants to make positive and effective life choices and decisions for the future, thereby fostering personal empowerment.

Session on the Importance of Counselling Among College Students

The Department of Psychology conducted a workshop titled "Learning and Behaviour Management in Children" on 12th August 2022 at the AC Seminar Hall. The session aimed to equip students with strategies to teach children values and habits necessary for working effectively in classrooms and achieving their goals. Through this workshop, students gained insights into learning disabilities and management skills helpful for dealing with disabled children.

Certificate Course on the Science of Happiness

The course aimed to cultivate an experience marked by positive emotions and educate participants on the emerging paradigm of positive psychology. It focused on building competencies for experiencing and sharing happiness as a lived experience. The course emphasised the scientific study of human flourishing and the pursuit of happiness, with practical approaches to leading more fulfilling and satisfying lives.

Awareness Class on Suicide Prevention Day

In connection with World Suicide Prevention Day, the Department of Psychology organised an awareness session on 14th October 2022 at the AC Seminar Hall. Aslam Siddique, a Clinical Psychologist from Psyfos Centre for Mental Health and Wellbeing, Manjeri, discussed recent suicide statistics, signs of vulnerability, and ways to help individuals with suicidal ideations. The

session helped students, as budding psychologists, understand their role in controlling mental health issues. The feedback from students indicated a positive response.

Field Visit to a Mental Hospital

The objective of this programme was to provide clinical exposure to students, enabling them to assess a wide range of psychological problems and treatment methods. Fifty-one second-year BSc Psychology students participated in the visit. Psychologist Father Edward Jorge explained the relationship between behaviour and the brain, the functioning of the hospital, and the services provided. Students were also able to clarify their doubts and queries during the visit.

Visit to a Special Education Centre

On 15th December 2022, a programme was conducted for disabled children, monitored by the students of the department, at the College Auditorium. Thirty-five disabled children, along with their mothers, nine staff members from ILU Thanal Intervention Centre, and 92 psychology students participated. The programme helped students understand various mental disabilities and aided in reducing social inhibition and stage fear among the disabled children. The programme was highly successful and received appreciation from participants and their families.

Horror House - "Nightmare Castle"

The Department of Psychology organised an immersive programme titled "Nightmare Castle" on 30th August 2022. The event aimed to entertain college students and raise funds. Its objectives included fostering creativity and group work, understanding illusion and hallucination, and exploring parapsychology. The event provided a thrilling and memorable experience while contributing to a noble cause.

Session on Career and Higher Education Opportunities in Psychology

The Department of Psychology organised a career orientation programme on 28th September 2022 at the AC Seminar Hall. The session introduced new career opportunities in psychology and guided students towards postgraduate programmes that enhance employability. It focused on preparing for PG entrance examinations and provided insights into central and state universities and exam preparation strategies.

Meeting with Industrial Experts

A movie screening of *Midsommar*, a 2019 film directed by Ari Aster, was organised under the guidance of Consultant Psychologists Abhinand S. and Anagha M. M. The film, a study of one woman's emotional journey towards emancipation from a toxic relationship, was followed by a session led by Ameena Sithara, Founder and Clinical Psychologist at Absolute Mind Clinic. The psychological elements of the film were discussed in detail with the students.



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ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2022-2023)

DEPARTMENT OF CHEMISTRY

Celebration of World Environment Day

The Department conducted a webinar titled "Revival of the Earth: It is in Our Hands" on 6th June 2022, in connection with World Environment Day. Dr. Litty Sebastian, Assistant Professor at Bharath Matha College, Trikkakkara, was the resource person. The primary aim of the World Environment Day celebration was to raise awareness and promote action on pressing environmental issues facing our planet.

Seminar on Waste Management

A seminar on solid waste management was organised by the department on 26th August 2022 as part of an environmental awareness initiative. Mr. Ashfak Ahamed from Green Dale Agropark delivered a talk. The awareness programme aimed to educate individuals and communities about the importance of proper waste management practices. Activities included public awareness campaigns, workshops, seminars, and community outreach initiatives.

Seminar in Connection with World Ozone Day

A seminar titled "35 Years of Healing" was held on 16th September 2022, in connection with World Ozone Day. Dr. Mehar Al Minnath, Assistant Professor at MES Mampad College, was the resource person. The programme aimed to raise awareness about the importance of protecting the ozone layer and commemorate the 35th anniversary of the Montreal Protocol, which was established to protect the ozone layer.

Community Outreach Programme

The department conducted a community outreach programme on 18th September 2022, titled "Hands-on Training in the Preparation and Effective Marketing of Hand Wash." The programme aimed to train the residents, particularly women, in nearby colonies on how to make hand wash and market it on a small scale. Participants gained an understanding of how to start their own business and enhance their economic power to earn a steady income.

International Webinar

An international webinar on "A General Approach to Project Report Writing" was conducted on 28th November 2022. Mr. Freddy Francis C, from National Tsinghua University, Taiwan, was the resource person. The aim of the webinar was to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of project report writing, covering the importance, key elements, and process for creating an effective project report. Practical tips and strategies were shared to help participants produce high-quality project reports.

Publication of Research Papers

Faculty members and PG students published research papers in national and international journals during the academic year.

Certificate Courses

- 1. Hands-on Training in Software Tools for Scientific Graphing and Molecular Modelling: This course aimed to equip participants with skills in searching and downloading research papers, scientific graphing, data analysis, and the use of open-source chemistry tools and molecular modelling.
- 2. *Hands-on Training on Polymer Processing*: The objective was to provide fundamental understanding and practical skills in rubber compounding.
- 3. *Effective Marketing of Hand Wash*: The course aimed to provide participants with practical skills in preparing and test marketing hand wash. Participants learned about product development, quality control, and the chemistry behind soap and hand wash production.
- 4. Structure Elucidation Using Molecular Spectroscopy: This course provided in-depth knowledge of the principles and techniques used to determine the molecular structure of organic compounds. It was targeted at chemistry students, researchers, and professionals.
- 5. *Molecular Visualization Software*: The course focused on drawing chemical structures, generating their names, and geometry optimisation, as well as visualising complex molecules.
- 6. Green Methods for Evergreen Earth: The objectives were to raise environmental awareness, promote sustainable resource management, and educate participants about climate change mitigation and how individuals and communities can contribute.

National/International Seminar

An international seminar on "Frontiers in Chemical Research" was conducted on 18th January 2023. Dr. Anokh K. Nair and Dr. Kala Kannan Kutty, from Taiwan, were the resource persons. The seminar aimed to bring together researchers, experts, and students in the field of chemical research to exchange knowledge, discuss current trends and challenges, and explore future directions for the field.

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Action Taken Report

Department of Commerce (2022-2023)

Community Outreach Programme 1: Promising Investment Avenues for Small Savings

On 27th July 2022, a programme titled "Promising Investment Avenues for Small Savings" was conducted. The aim was to create awareness about small investment options for local residents and students near the college. The session highlighted low-risk and easily accessible investment options, encouraging a culture of savings and investment among the youth and local communities. Participants gained practical knowledge on how to manage and grow their savings.

Community Outreach Programme 2: Higher Education Opportunities for Commerce Graduates

On 29th September 2022, a session titled "Higher Education Opportunities for Commerce Graduates" was organised. The objective was to guide commerce graduates on building a successful career by exploring opportunities in higher education. The programme helped students understand the available postgraduate options, scholarships, and career paths in the field of commerce. Students left with a clearer vision of the steps needed to advance their careers in this domain.

Community Outreach Programme 3: Share Market and Trading Awareness

In October 2022, a programme focused on "Share Market and Trading Awareness" was conducted. The objective was to educate participants about the functioning of the stock market and the basics of trading. The session provided insights into the risks and rewards of investing in shares and guided participants on how to start their trading journey. It aimed to enhance financial literacy concerning stock investments.

Community Outreach Programme 4: Financial Empowerment

In November 2022, the department conducted a session on "Financial Empowerment". This outreach initiative aimed to improve the financial status of individuals by educating them on personal finance management. Topics such as budgeting, saving, and long-term wealth planning were covered, helping participants take control of their financial futures. The session provided tools and strategies for achieving financial independence.

Community Outreach Programme 5: Business Opportunities in the Food Industry

On 15th January 2023, a session on "Business Opportunities in the Food Industry" was held. It introduced participants to various business opportunities within the rapidly growing food industry. The programme covered aspects like market demand, entry strategies, and financial considerations for starting food-related businesses. Participants gained valuable knowledge on how to tap into the food market and explore entrepreneurial avenues.

Community Outreach Programme 6: Emerging Opportunities in Digital Marketing

In February 2023, a programme on "Emerging Opportunities in Digital Marketing" was conducted. It focused on educating students about the importance of digital marketing in the modern economy. Topics such as social media strategies, content creation, and the use of data analytics to optimise marketing efforts were covered. Participants learned how to leverage digital platforms to achieve marketing success.

Experiential Learning 1

On 31st October 2022, an experiential learning session was organised to engage students through hands-on learning experiences, combined with reflection. This programme aimed to develop critical skills and knowledge by allowing students to apply theoretical concepts in practical settings, enhancing their understanding and retention. Sixteen such experiential learning programmes were conducted throughout the year.

Experiential Learning 2

On 29th November 2022, another session was held to provide students with opportunities to explore different options for pursuing higher education. This session helped students make informed decisions about their academic future by highlighting various postgraduate courses and available scholarships.

Commercial Stalls (As Part of Consumer Day)

On 23rd December 2022, commercial stalls were set up as part of *Consumer Day* to educate students on fair trade practices. This initiative aimed to raise awareness about ethical business practices and the importance of consumer rights in the marketplace. Students were encouraged to engage with real-world business dynamics through hands-on activities.

Workshop 1: Identification of Research Topic

In November 2022, a workshop was conducted to guide students in selecting relevant research topics, especially those with social significance. The session provided students with tools to identify gaps in existing research and craft meaningful research questions. Participants left with a clearer understanding of how to approach their academic research effectively.

Workshop 2: Construction of Questionnaire

In December 2022, a workshop focused on teaching students the essential components of constructing a well-designed questionnaire was organised. The session covered principles of question design, survey structuring, and ensuring data validity and reliability. Students gained practical skills in conducting empirical research.

Regional Seminar: Virtual Shopping and the Future of Physical Outlets

In November 2022, a seminar on "Virtual Shopping and the Future of Physical Outlets" was held. Experts discussed the rapid rise of virtual shopping and its impact on physical retail stores. The seminar encouraged participants to critically analyse the evolving dynamics of consumer behaviour and its effect on the future of brick-and-mortar outlets.

National Seminar: Technological Innovation in Business and Strategies for Sustainable Entrepreneurial Practices

In December 2022, a national seminar on "Technological Innovation in Business and Strategies for Sustainable Entrepreneurial Practices" was conducted. The seminar brought together entrepreneurs and business experts to discuss the role of technological innovation in driving sustainable business practices. Topics included green technologies, business model innovation, and strategies for long-term growth, providing insights into sustainable entrepreneurship.

International Conference: International Tax Reforms and Sustainable Investment

In January 2023, an international conference titled "International Tax Reforms and Sustainable Investment" was held. The session highlighted diverse career paths and emerging industries that value skills over degrees, motivating students to think creatively and explore unconventional career options.

Career Guidance Seminar 3: Interview & Group Discussion

In January 2023, a seminar focused on preparing students for the job market by teaching essential interview and group discussion techniques. Participants learned how to present themselves confidently, articulate their thoughts clearly, and navigate challenging questions in a professional setting, equipping them with the skills needed to succeed in job interviews.

Career Guidance Webinar: Cracking Central Government and Competitive Exams

In February 2023, a webinar on "Cracking Central Government and Competitive Exams" was conducted. It provided strategies for effective study, time management, and navigating the application process for government jobs. Participants received expert advice on how to confidently approach competitive exams and succeed.



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DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

ACTION TAKEN REPORT (2022-2023)

Field Visit

The History Association of Manjeri KAHM Unity Women's College has advocated for the preservation of *Kodakallu*, a remnant from the Megalithic period, located at Pattarkulam. This stone-built *Kudakallu*, situated on a paddy field 200 meters from Pattarkulam Angadi, was used to bury human bodies during the Megalithic period. The Kerala government declared this *Kudakallu* a protected monument in 2020. On 13th September 2022, students and teachers from the third-year BA History department visited Pattarkulam *Kudakallu*.

Local History Workshop for School Students

On 17th February 2023, five students from the Department of History visited HMS Higher Secondary School, Thurakkal, to introduce the significance of history as an academic discipline. Third-year students, along with programme coordinator Ms. Jaseena, interacted with the Plus One Humanities students, discussing career opportunities in the field of history.

Experiential Learning Trip

On 11th February 2023, second-semester BA History students from the department visited the historical site Edakkal Caves and the 900 Kandi Eco-Park in Wayanad. The students explored the habitat and Stone Age carvings of Neolithic people as well as the rich biological diversity of Wayanad.

Compulsory Study Trip to North India

From 30th December 2022 to 8th January 2023, as part of an academic activity, final-year BA History students and teachers from the History Department conducted a study tour to Agra, Delhi, and Manali. A total of 35 final-year BA History students and three faculty members participated in this compulsory study tour.

Gandhi & Women Empowerment on the Occasion of Gandhi Jayanti

On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, the Department of History hosted an online talk on the topic "Gandhi and Women Empowerment." Ms. Aswathy P, a final-year BA History student, presented the topic, focusing on Gandhi's views on young widows and the role of women in social service and progress.

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DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

Action Taken Report

The **English Department** at the college conducted a variety of events and activities during the academic year 2022-2023, aimed at enriching students' academic and personal development.

On **22nd June 2022**, an *invited lecture* on Dalit aesthetics and politics in C. Ayyappan's short stories was organised.
