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
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Actions Taken by the IQAC towards the Quality Benchmarking of End Semester University Examination 2023-24

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ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2023-2024

Department of Psychology

The Department of Psychology offered a Certificate course on Life Skill Education from June 16, 2023, to November 3, 2023. The main objective of the course was to encompass a comprehensive curriculum focused on personal and professional development. The course aimed to enhance life skills essential for success, including self-awareness, empathy, effective communication, problem-solving, decision-making, interpersonal relations, and career development. Fifty students were the beneficiaries of the programme.

CAPP (Case Analysis on Psychology Programme) was conducted for the fifth semester BSc Psychology students from 10th August 2023 to 10th January 2024 with 30 hours duration in which 27 students completed the course. Throughout the course, the students engaged in case studies and relaxation techniques. By the end of the course the students gained the practical skills and knowledge for their further studies and also they can enhance insights into individuals, groups, or communities to better understand their thoughts and behaviours.

The certificate course on Psychological First Aid was successfully completed by 36 second-semester and 38 fourth-semester BSc Psychology students. The course aimed to enhance learners' abilities to apply psychological first aid, manage psychological crisis reactions, and emphasize the importance of self and team care for helpers. The syllabus covered the basics of psychological first aid, professional behaviour guidelines, and core actions such as contact, engagement, and stabilizing emotions. It also focused on strategies for self-care and team care during crisis situations. Upon completion, students were equipped to deliver psychological first aid effectively and apply self-care strategies before, during, and after crisis interventions.

The third-year BSc Psychology students of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri undertook a commendable initiative by providing life skills training to upper primary students at HMS AUP Thurakkal School, Manjeri on 29th September 2023. Covering essential topics such as 'Body Safety and Personal Boundaries,' 'Personal Hygiene and Puberty Education,' and 'Bullying Prevention,' these budding psychologists aimed to empower the young minds with crucial life skills. Through engaging and age-appropriate activities, the students sensitively addressed the importance of understanding personal boundaries and body safety, fostering good personal hygiene practices, and strategies to combat bullying.

The Department of Psychology conducted various capacity building program in the year 2023-2024, which are Reopening of counselling cell, International Yoga Day Celebration, Awareness classes on World suicide prevention day, Workshop on listening skills ,Session on media and psychology, Class on personality disorders, Budding Psychologist Program, Debates

on socially relevant topics. Through the capacity building programme students can enhance improved skills and knowledge, enhanced organizational performance and increased self-sufficiency among the students.

On January 22, 2024 the Department of Psychology inaugurated the Buddy Project (a community outreach program) for differently abled children at the seminar hall. The event marked the beginning of a meaningful initiative aimed at fostering support and companionship for disabled children within the community. The major outcomes of the programme were promoting inclusive education, enhancing social skills, promoting emotional support and peer awareness among the students.

Department of Botany

Manna 2023: Mushroom Culture Program

The Mushroom Culture Program conducted by the PG Department of Botany on November 14, 2023, aimed at imparting best practices in mushroom cultivation. The primary objective of the program was to provide students with practical knowledge and hands-on experience in mushroom cultivation. Students were actively engaged in hands-on practical sessions where they learned the step-by-step process of cultivating mushrooms. The coordinators demonstrated substrate preparation, inoculation techniques, and the crucial parameters of maintaining a conducive growing environment. The program successfully achieved its objective of imparting best practices in mushroom cultivation.

Organic Uni-vegetable Garden 2023.

On 21st November 2023, PG Department of Botany restarted Organic Farming (Organic Uni-vegetable Garden) with an objective of giving students first-hand experience with nature and gardening by providing a phase of manual training on the usage of tools and implements in the gardening processes together with the preparation of cultivating soil. the Tomato seedling in the organic cultivating area of Polyhouse was purchased from Daliya Nursery and Garden, Anakkayam, Manjeri. As per the advice provided by the gardener, First Semester B.Sc. Botany students helped to prepare the cultivating area and planted the vegetable seedlings viz. Lycopersicum esculentum, Capsicum annuum, Abelmoschus esculentus and Vigna unguiculata properly in the drip irrigated site. On the completion of the programme, the students developed critical understanding on various aspects of agronomy and realized the role of organic farming to maintain environment health by reducing the level of pollution.

One Student One Tree Campaign 2023'

As part of 'Van Mahotsav' 2023, P.G. Department of Botany, KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, organized 'One Student One Tree Campaign 2023' on 07th July 2023. It is an annual tree planting movement in the college to raise the awareness about benefits of trees and to encourage students to become more active in environmental conservation efforts. The students contributed various tree seedlings including *Syzygium aromaticum* (*L.*) *Merr. & Perry, Mangifera indica L., Bambusa bambos* (*L.*) *Voss in Vilmorin, Saraca asoca* (*Roxb.*) *de Wilde, Anacardium occidentale L., etc.*. The seedlings planted in the Biodiversity Park (Botanical Garden) of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, in turn acts as one of the germplasm conservation centres of rare and endangered trees.

Vermicompost Harvesting: A Hand to Nature

On 10th November 2023, PG Department of Botany, KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, organized the harvesting of vermicompost organic manure and handed over to the collaborated Plant Nursery, Green Gate, Chadikkallu, Manjeri. In exchange, they provided the saplings of *Melastoma sp.*, *Asplenium sp.*, *Echinocactus sp.*, *Gardenia sp.*, *Zamia sp. etc.* to the Department for enforcing plant diversity conservation. The programme was conducted to create

an idea about composting the organic wastes to produce superior quality manure for feeding our "nutrient or organic matter hungry" soils.

The production and distribution of vermicompost, the soil conditioner and plant feeding material produced by earthworm species (*Eudrilus eugeniae*) on the basis of changing the physical and chemical structure of bovine faeces, played as extension activity of the Department which focuses on the natural restoration and protection of ecosystem. Through this organic waste recycling procedure, students are more likely to learn about the importance of protecting the planet and take action in their own lives together with their academic life.

Food fest

On 22-12-2023, the first semester students of the PG Department of botany orchestrated the vibrant 'Flavor Fiesta' alongside the college Christmas celebration. The event showcased an array of culinary wonders, ranging from diverse juices to appetizing snacks, delightful desserts and fulfilling main courses.

International Yoga Day Celebration

Commerce Association and Psychology Association jointly organized Yoga Day celebration on 22nd June 2023 on the occasion of International Yoga Day. The programme was conducted in two sessions. The first session was a *yoga asana* demonstration and practice led by NCC Under Officer Ayisha Risni K (5th Semester, B.Sc Psychology) and the second was a meditation led by Mr. Hamraz Ahamed M (Head and Assistant Professor, Department of Physical Education).

Department of Home Science

The PG Department of Home Science celebrated International Yoga Day on June 21st 2023 to disseminate information about the countless benefits of practicing yoga. This day serves as a platform to raise awareness about the holistic approach to well-being that yoga offers. It encouraged physical, mental, and spiritual balance. The session was instructed and demonstrated by Ms. Loosiya KP, Assistant Professor (Adhoc), Dept. of Home Science. She explained about various asanas and their benefits and the importance of Yoga in daily life. Around 28 students participated in the session.

As part of 'International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking', the PG Department of Home Science organised a film show on 26th June 2023, at the college Digital Studio. Two Malayalam short films namely 'Avabodha' and 'Adisthanam' with the theme of drug abuse were shown to the students. By creating a conducive environment for knowledge exchange and skill enhancement, the initiative aims to empower students to develop their own brand of tote bags or start their own small-scale ventures. The webinar aimed to educate participants about the various industries related to their subject. The event provided the students with a practical understanding of the industry and enlightened them about the importance of being aware of their role in the industry. The resource person for the webinar was Ms. Shamna Mohasine, Senior Analyst, Signature Solutions. She gave an overview of the several international certificates that were needed for getting placement in various industries in India and abroad. She also pointed out the various services and courses offered by their institute.

Certificate Course in Basic Life Support (BLS)

The Postgraduate Department of Home Science, in collaboration with Aster Mother Hospital, Areacode, organized a Basic Life Support (BLS) Certificate course for 5th semester UG and I and II PG students. The course aimed to equip participants with essential life-saving skills and knowledge in emergency situations. The practical session of the certificate course was conducted for two days on October 26th and 27th, 2023. The major objectives of the BLS certificate course were to provide participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to respond effectively in emergencies, to teach participants how to recognize life-threatening situations and initiate immediate action, to familiarize participants with basic life support techniques, such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the use of automated external defibrillators (AEDs), to enable participants to handle choking incidents, respiratory distress, and unconsciousness effectively. The training program followed an interactive and hands-on approach to facilitate

effective learning. It included a combination of theoretical lectures, practical demonstrations, and simulated emergency scenarios. Experienced trainers from Aster Mother Hospital were invited to conduct the sessions, ensuring that participants received expert guidance throughout the course. The training was conducted by the Emergency Department of the Aster Mother Hospital. Mr. Salmanul Farisin was the chief instructor. He gave the basic instructions of BLS. At the end of the session Mr. Naseer, CEO of Aster Mother Hospital joined, shared his experiences, and encouraged students to do BLS in need.

Awareness Class on Immunisation

The PG Department of Home Science celebrated World Immunisation Day by providing an awareness class on 'The Importance of Immunisation', intended to create awareness on taking timely vaccinations for protection against various diseases. The awareness class was taken by Mrs. Bahira M, a student of the 3rd semester M.Sc. Home Science - Nutrition & Dietetics. She explained the benefits of Immunisation, its significance, and immunization schedules for pregnant women, infants, and children. Students from various departments participated in the session and clarified their doubts.

Visit to Tea and Chocolate Factory

National Webinar on "Gourmet to Grocery: The Journey of Food Product Commercialization"

The PG department of Home Science and Home Science Innovation and Incubation Centre jointly organised a National Webinar on "Gourmet to Grocery: The Journey of Food Product Commercialization" on 05.12.2023 at 2.15pm through google meet. The webinar aimed at facilitating a deep understanding of the process of food product development and scaling up with precision for marketing. Dr. A. Thahira Banu, Assistant Professor at Gandhigram Rural Institute, Tamil Nadu, delivered a keynote on the scientific process of food product development and commercialization. She shared her journey of transforming local ideas into profitable food products and discussed the challenges of obtaining patents. The session was followed by an interactive Q&A with 84 participants, including students and staff from various colleges across and outside Kerala.

Seminar on Cancer Cervix

A seminar on Cancer Cervix Awareness in connection with Cervical Cancer Awareness Month was organized by the Department of Home Science on 25.01.2024. The seminar began with the welcome note by Dr. Annie Ninan, the Coordinator of the programme. This was followed by the inaugural speech by the Principal, Prof. Dr. Muhammed Basheer Ummathur. He highlighted the hazardous nature of free radicals causing damage to the cells thus playing a role in the development of cancer. The Resource person Ms. Liyana Abdul Jabbar, I Sem M Sc Home Science student delivered the lecture with a brief overview on the basis of cervical cancer. The causes, symptoms, risk factors and strategies for prevention including vaccination and lifestyle changes were discussed. She also highlighted the importance of early detection. The seminar successfully raised awareness about cervical cancer, with participants gaining valuable knowledge about prevention and early detection.

Career Guidance Session on Medical Coding

DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

Add-on Course An Add-on Course was conducted for second-year BA students focusing on proficiency for competitive exams. The aim of the course was to enhance students' English language proficiency to prepare them for competitive exams and provide IELTS training in listening skills.

The Department of Chemistry at our institution has been actively involved in a range of educational and awareness programmes during the academic year 2023-2024.

Certificate Courses:

The department offered several certificate courses to provide students with practical skills and indepth knowledge in various areas of chemistry:

1. Certificate Course I: Preparation and Marketing of Cleansing Agents

This course, held from August to December 2023, focused on the formulation and marketing of cleansing agents. Students gained practical insights into the chemical processes involved in preparing cleansing products and explored marketing strategies for these products. This course was especially beneficial for students interested in the commercial and industrial applications of chemistry.

2. Certificate Course II: Hands-on Training in Polymer Compounding
