# STUDY ABROAD – CAREER GUIDANCE SESSION BY MATGLOBER CAREERS – 21 JUNE 2022



# IMPORTANCE AND SCOPE OF ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION – 21 JULY 2022








### CAREER PROSPECTS IN MARINE SCIENCES - 21 OCTOBER, 2022







# GATEWAY TO CENTRAL UNIVERSITIES (AMU) 6<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY 2023

### CAREER GUIDANCE AND CYBERSECURITY AWARENESS – 14 FEBRUARY 2023


A guidance and awareness session on cybersecurity was organized for final year BSc. Computer Science students. Resource persons from Cyber crews hacker academy shared the resource.





### JOB PROSPECTS IN MEDICAL CODING 23 FEBRUARY 2023




### CAT MOCK TEST - 14 SEPTEMBER 2022

### STEPS: ONLINE COACHING FOR COMPETITIVE EXAMS








# PUBLIC SERVICE CLUB MEMBERSHIP AND ONLINE CLASSES FOR KAS EXAM


### PASSWORD 2022-23 – 09 DECEMBER 2022


