





### **JULY 2022**

### Learning Pahadi Natti








### **Open Link Awareness Quiz on 'Land of Gods'**


# SHARING "KERALA CUISINE" VIDEO WITH ST. BEDE'S COLLEGE, HIMACHAL PRADESH

# SHARING ONAM (HINDI) VIDEO WITH ST. BEDE'S COLLEGE, HIMACHAL PRADESH




# GANDHI JAYANTHI QUIZ WITH ST. BEDE'S COLLEGE, HIMACHAL PRADESH
