Documentary- dark energy and dark matter

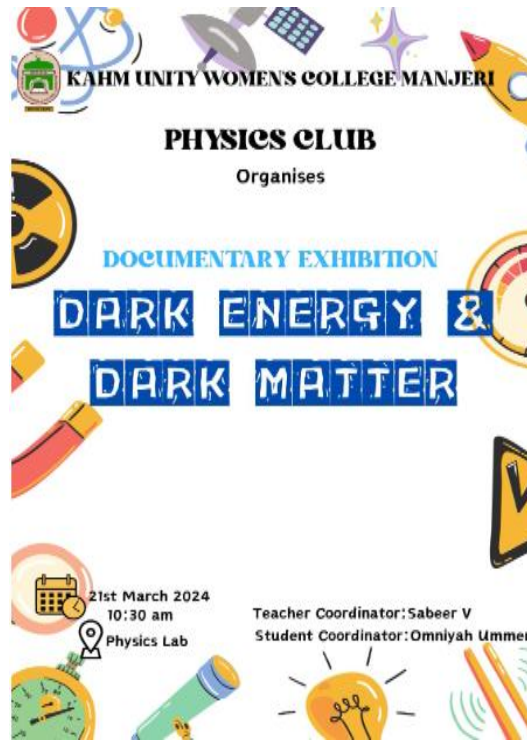

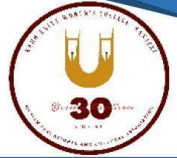
Higher education scenario with reference to barcelona university and aligarh muslim university
