
### 5. Workshop on Digital Poster Making

### 7. Local History Workshop




#### 9. Poster Release

#### 12. The Freedom Wall was unveiled at Unity College



In ancient times, bodies buried in Nannangadi, were surrounded by three or four big pieces of stones and a mushroom-shaped lid on top. Unity Women's College Department of History has urged that such monuments, which shed light on an era, need to be preserved. The students have decided to put up a sign board at Patarkulam.. 
### 19. Monthly Alumni Lecture Series - Talk 2

### 22. World Students Day (Association Programme)


