Teachers' Work Diary



• IPR Online Workshop for 500 Students in Collaboration with Patent Office Chennai:










• UNITY GATE (Gifted and Talented Education): An IQAC Platform for Advanced Learners:

• Setting Up of Institutional LMS: Moodle

College under the recommendation of IQAC decided to purchase learning management system for managing teaching, learning and evaluation through online mode as a preparedness for enhancing remote learning. This was introduced as step towards achieving ICT enabled teaching learning ecosystem as envisaged in NEP 2020. Dr Bajeel P N was appointed as the LMS Coordinator. The meeting of college manager, principal, IQAC Coordinator, Convenor of criterion IV and LMS Coordinator was held in December 2022. The meeting discussed the prospects of purchasing LMS for the institution and decided to implement the same.

• Formation of Student Quality Assurance Cell (SQAC)

In order to ensure the total quality assurance of the institution and to effectively implement all the quality initiatives for all stakeholders, IQAC decided to form student quality assurance cell (SQAC). It is decided to select two students from each class as SQAC members. Thus, an effective three tier system (IQAC – DQAC-SQAC) of quality assurance is implemented by IQAC for smooth conduct of all quality initiatives.

Participation in NIRF

The institution participated in the National Institutional Ranking Framework. Dr Shahina Mol A. K served as the NIRF Coordinator of the institution during the year. It was decided to promote faculty publication and research in the evaluation meeting held by IQAC in the light of NIRF Report.

New Collaborations & MOUs

As part of the strategic plan, IQAC took initiatives to increase collaborations and MOUs with more institutions of higher learning, local self - governments, Higher education Council of Kerala state and other government and non- government institutions. All the departments were directed to have collaborative initiatives for faculty exchange, student exchange and research. IQAC ensured that there are programmes conducted by the departments and institution to make MOUs and collaborations functional.

• Vision@30: An Institutional Perspective Plan in Connection with 30th Anniversary

Vision @30 was a special initiative of IQAC in connection with 30th anniversary of the institution. Established in 1991, the institution completed 30 years of excellent existence in 2021. The strategic plan was proposed by IQAC as per the suggestion of college governing body. IQAC Coordinator Dr Shahina Mol A. K., submitted a strategic plan titled vision@30. It was decided in consultation with IQAC members and all the staff members of the college. Dr Pakkrutty T K., Treasurer of college governing body and former principal, provided opportunity for all staff to submit the proposal to be considered in for implementation in vision@30 plan. "30 new projects in connection with 30th anniversary" is consolidated as Vision @30. It was agreed by the IQAC in the meeting and decided to implement the plan through a period of one year.

Inauguration of RUSA Building on 29 April 2022

The RUSA block inauguration was held on 29 April 2022. Honourable Higher education minister of Kerala state inaugurated the event state -wide and delivered the keynote address. Principal, Management members, IQAC Coordinator, Teaching and non- teaching staff members and select students attended the session.

Inauguration of New Science Block on 7 January 2022

The inauguration of new science block, constructed by the college governing body was held on 7 January 2022. The block was inaugurated by Hon. Higher education Minister of Kerala State, Dr Bindu P, in the session chaired by President of college governing body, Janab. Munavvar Ali Shihab Thangal. Vice President, Secretary, Joint Secretary and executive members of the college governing body were present on the occasion along with principal, college manager, staff and students.

• Award Ceremony to World Moral Day Winners on 6 January 2022

The award distribution ceremony to winners of World Moral Day Competition and the Korambayil Ahamed Haji Memorial Lecture were held on 6 January 2022. Hon. Member of Parliament Abdussamad Samadani was the chief guest. He delivered the memorial lecture on founder of the college January Korambayil Ahamed Haji MP. The national level winners were awarded the prizes.

• G- Suit Purchase

College under the recommendation of IQAC purchased G -suit for enhanced academic activities during COVID-19. It helped in organizing more faculty and student -oriented sessions, seminars etc., without compromising quality during the pandemic period.

One Day National Workshop for Principals & IQAC Coordinators by National Science Foundation

Principal Dr C Saidalavi, IQAC Coordinator Dr Shahina Mol A.K, and Associate Professor and Head of Chemistry Dr Muhammed Basheer Ummathur attended one day national level workshop for IQAC Coordinator and Principal on various quality audits. The workshop was organized by National Science Foundation, Tamilnadu.

• Three Day National Residential Workshop for IQAC Coordinator & Governing Body Members

College governing body members Prof PN Abdurahiman, former principal, college manager Er. O Abdul Ali, Associate Professor cum senior faculty Dr. Muhammed Basheer Ummathur and IQAC Coordinator Dr Shahina Mol A. K, attended three- day national level residential workshop for governing body members and IQAC coordinator, organized by WMO IG college, Wayanad in March 2022. The prime focus of the workshop was on NEP 2020 implementation: Prospects & Preparedness at the institutional level.

• New Certificate Courses and Add on Courses

IQAC directed all the departments to conduct more Certificate/ Add on courses to bridge the academy-industry gap and to ensure academic flexibility. The certificate courses helped in offering mobility to students and to open the doors of multidisciplinary openings. It was mandated that one student has to take at least one certificate course offered by parent department or other department in an academic year. The regulations and quality parameters for conducting certificate/ add on courses were also circulated by IQAC. 14 new courses were introduced in the year 2021-2022.

• Edu carefree ships – An IQAC Initiative

IQAC took the initiative to continue the department level free ship titled "Edu care freeship" to meritorious UG and PG students from each batch during each year. This was introduced in 2020-21. IQAC ensured that all departments continue this student support initiative.

• IQAC sponsored Honoring Ceremonies for Student Achievers

IQAC initiated department wise honouring ceremonies for batch toppers and other student achievers. This initiative helped in motivating students to achieve higher potentials and helped in inculcating quality academic culture in the institution. IQAC, with the assistance of college management financially supported the departments for the same.
