



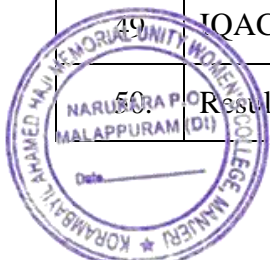

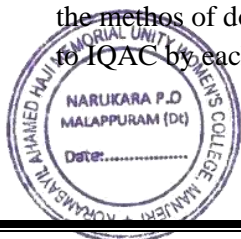


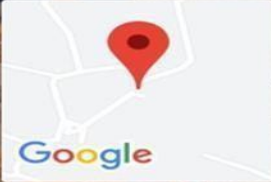
- **Unity@30- Kick off meetings**

- **IQAC – Criterion wise meetings and operational planning**

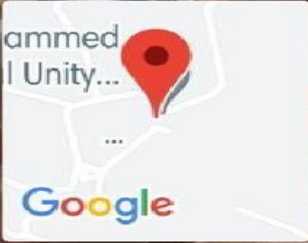

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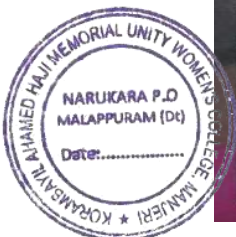
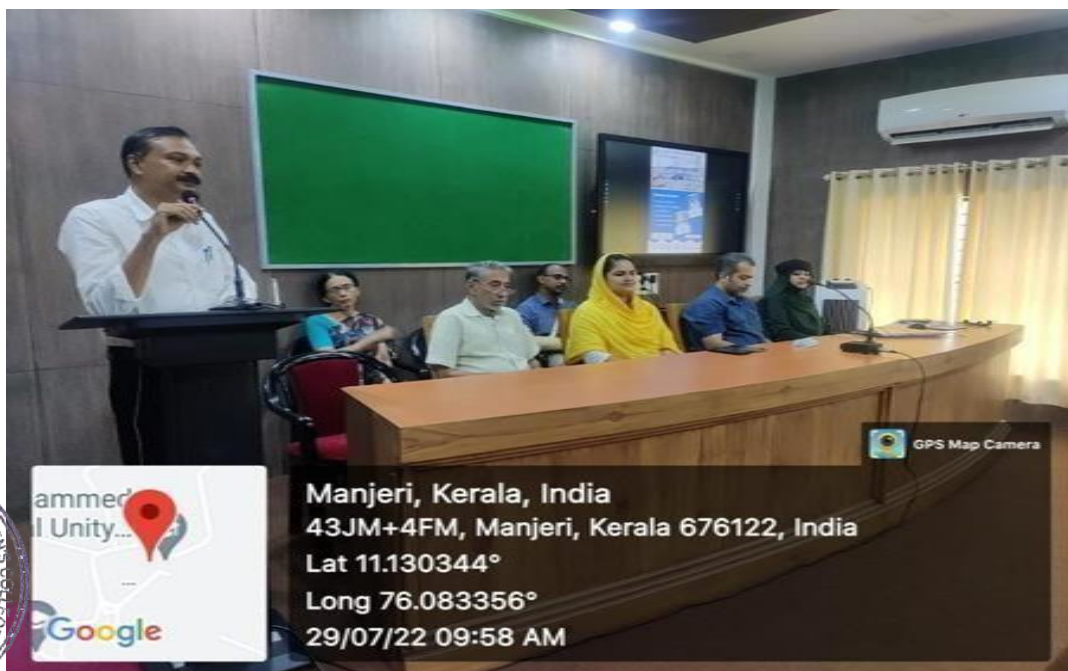
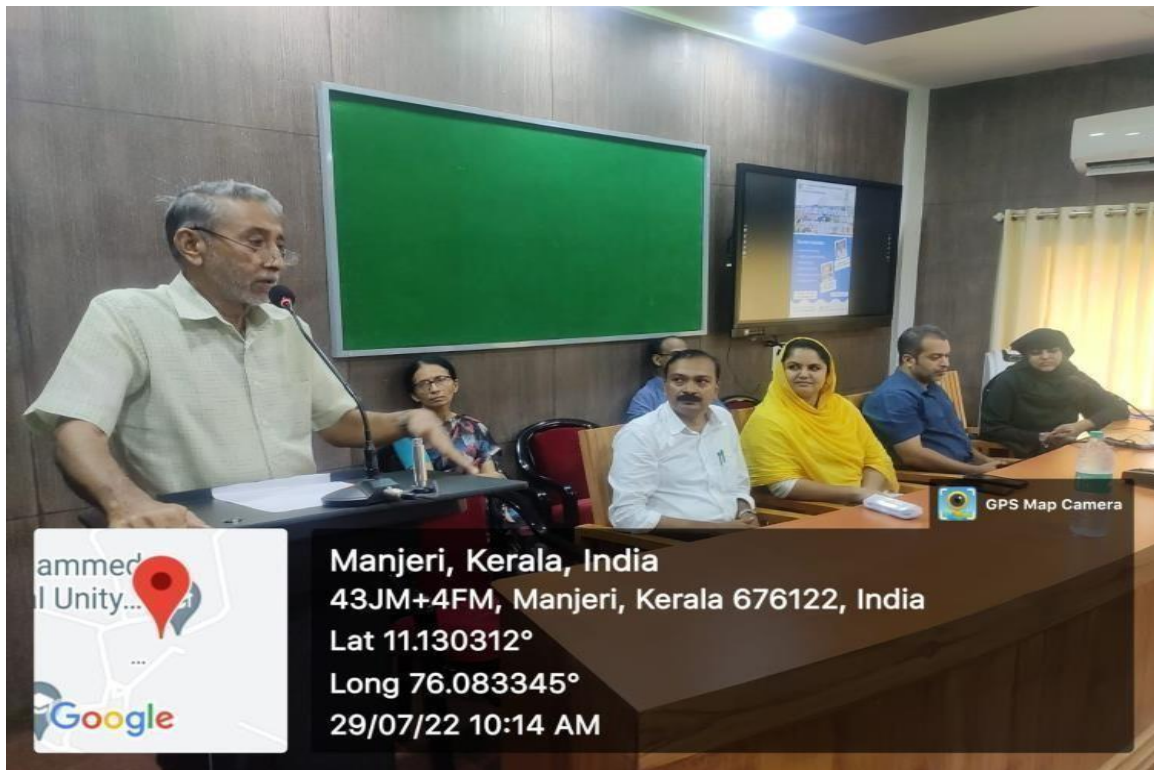


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PRODIGY PATH :-Day 2, Launching of Learning Management System (LMS) and the Faculty Development Workshop- 2

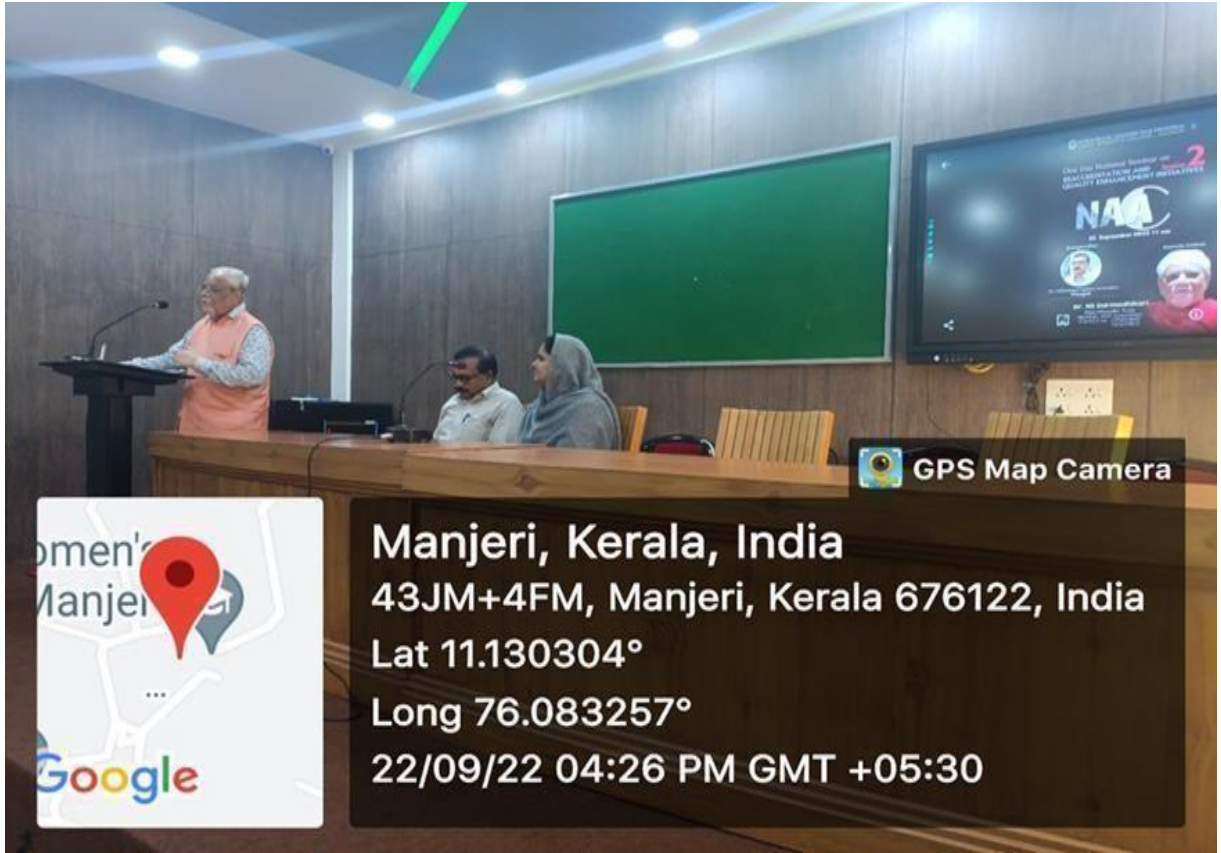

Prodigy Path Day 7 Faculty Workshop on Digital Content Development: -

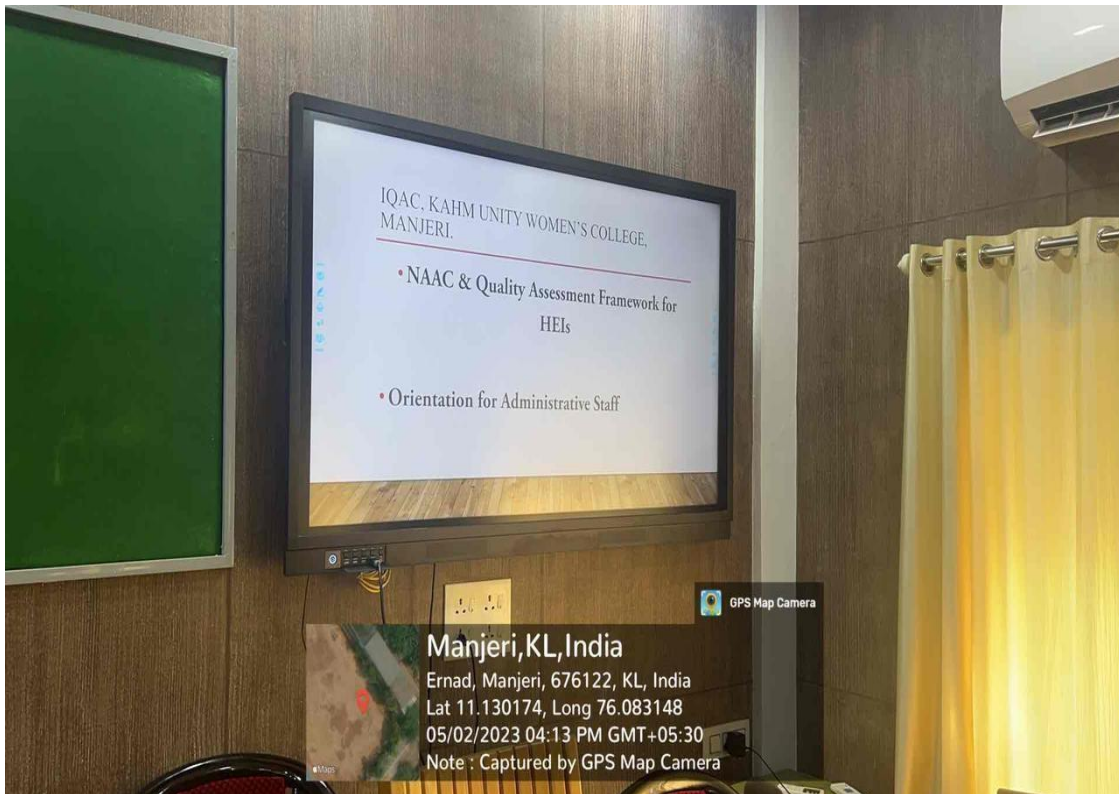

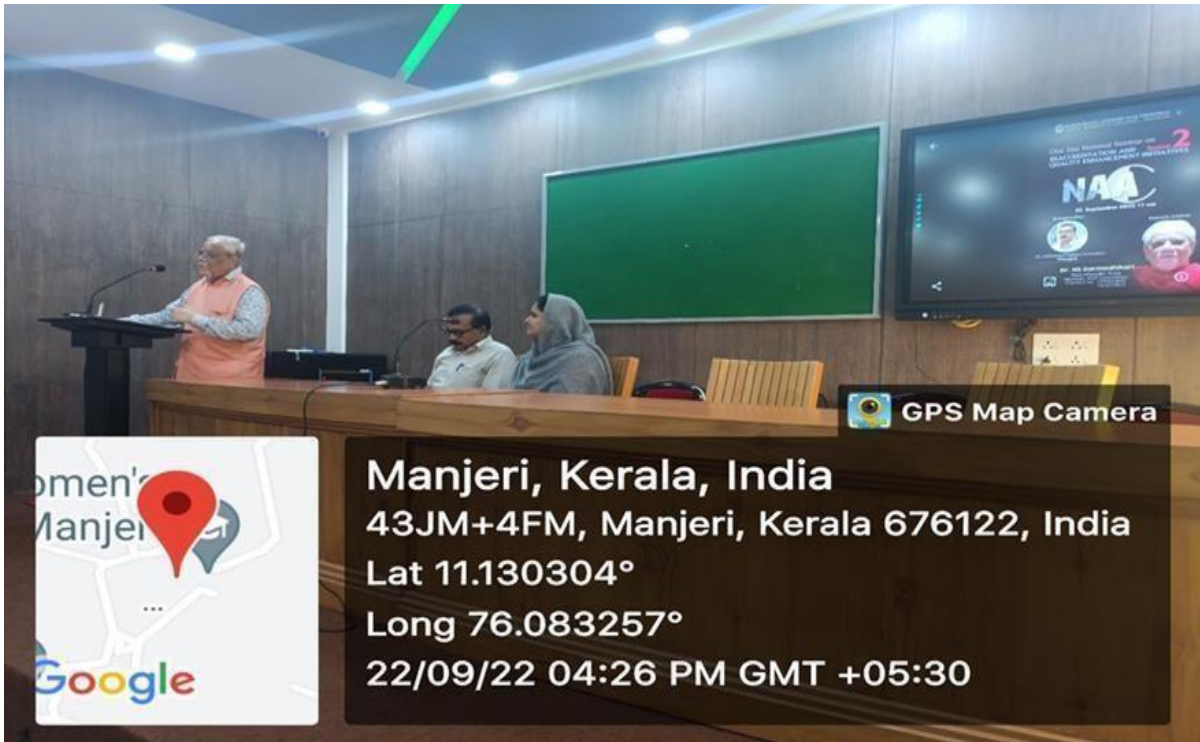

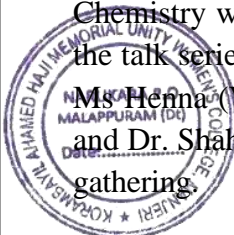
Confluence: A platform for Quality Sustenance and Annual Academic and Administrative Audits: Day 2

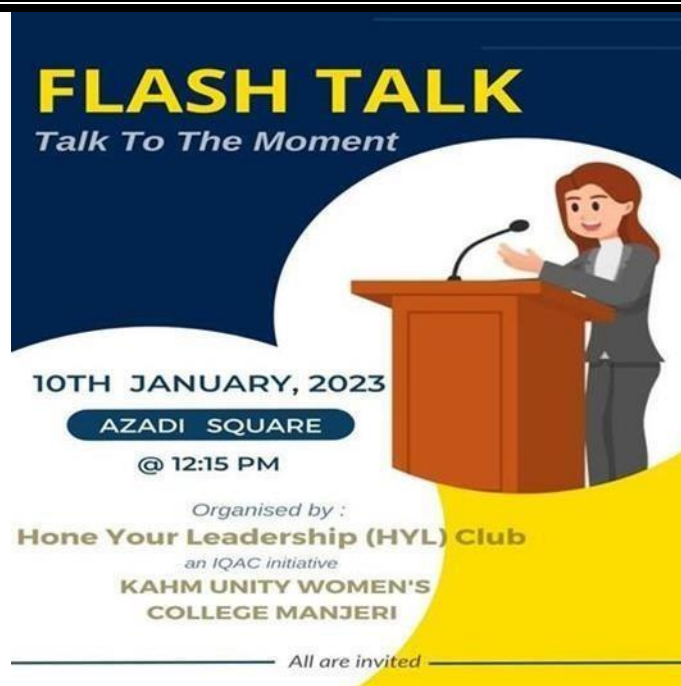

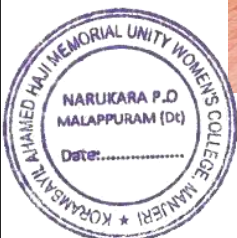


Faculty Focus: IQAC Platform for Inter Collegial Dialogue.

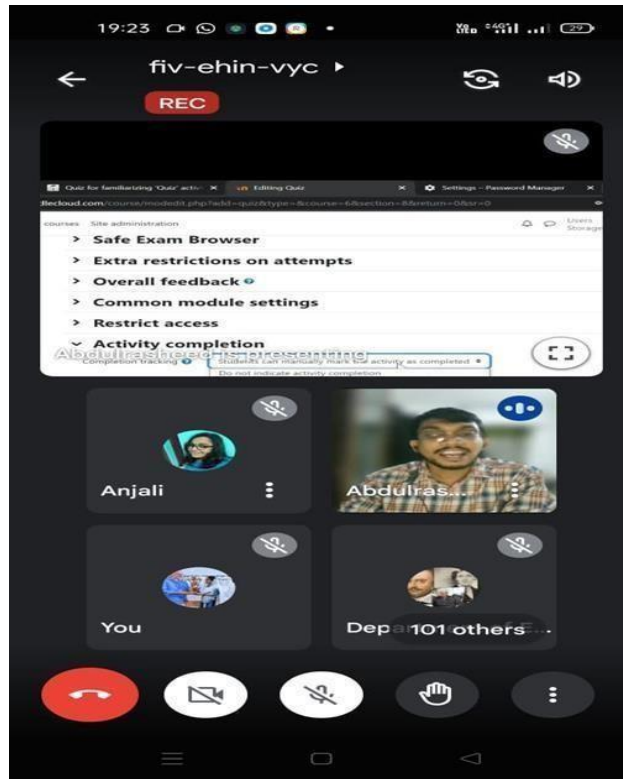

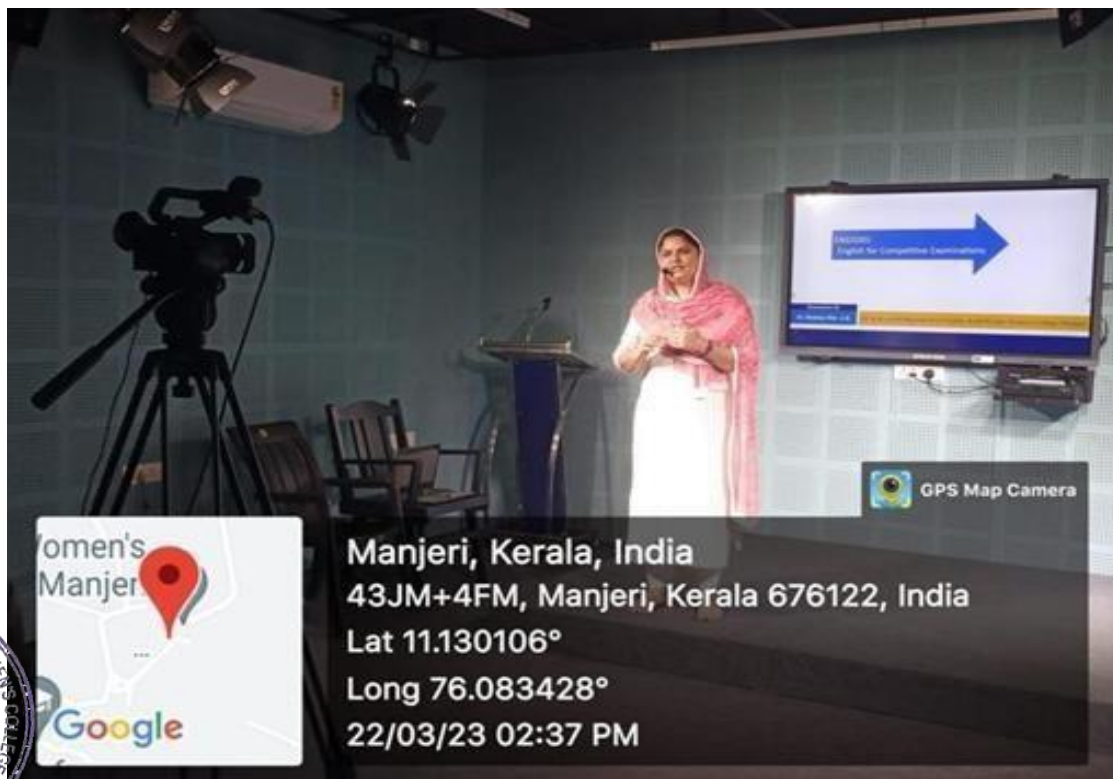
One week FDP on Moodle Based LMS and Course Design sponsored by KSHEC

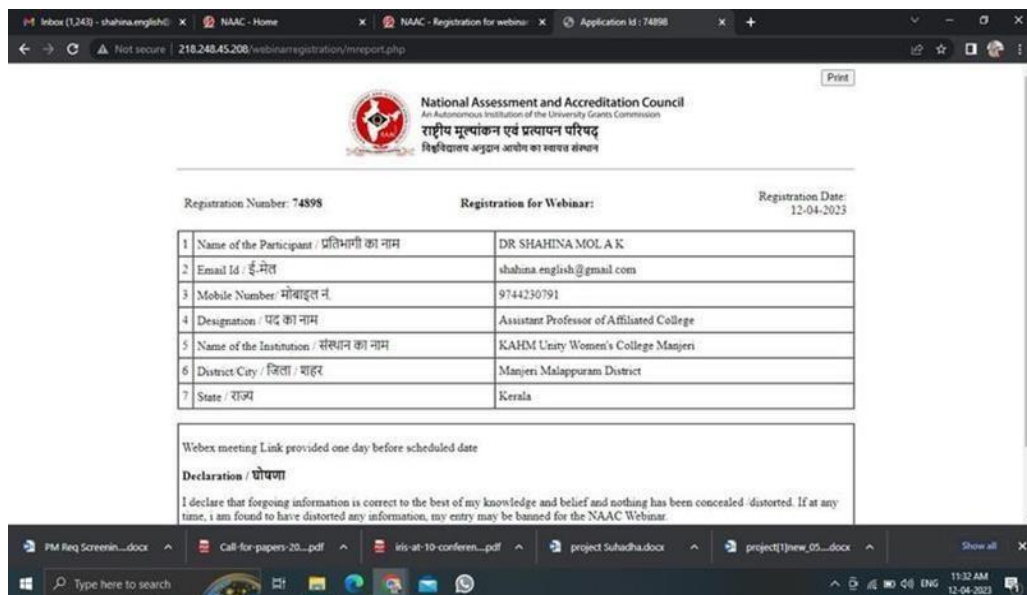

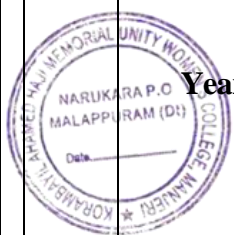




- **Participation of Faculty Members and Administrative Staff in HRDC Training and other Faculty Development Programmes:**
