
• Springboard: Induction Programme for the First Semester Undergraduate Students








PRODIGY PATH :-Day 2, Launching of Learning Management System (LMS) and the Faculty Development Workshop- 2














Unity @ 30: Logo Release of 30th anniversary celebrations of the College



Flash Talk: Talk to the Moment – Second Edition



Faculty Focus: IQAC Platform for Inter Collegial Dialogue.




One week FDP on Moodle Based LMS and Course Design sponsored by KSHEC




Quality Audits of the College


Academic Audit 2022-23: Phase I


Ambedkar Jayanti - Commemoration
