



INTRODUCTION

The Shihab Thangal Library & Information Centre at KAHM Unity Women's College is a 9,000 sq ft, two-storey facility with 22,689 books, reference materials, and a textbook bank. The library subscribes to national and international journals, periodicals, and newspapers, serving students, research scholars, and faculty.



It offers a reading area, digital resource centre, career corner, smart conference room and reprographic services. Fully automated with the 'Koha' Integrated Library Management Software and accessible via the Web based Online Public Access Catalogue (WEBOPAC), it offers remote access to e-resources like N-LIST and DELNET. The library is well-equipped with Wi-Fi and IT-enabled security through CCTV surveillance. Regular workshops, seminars and awareness programmes promote research and reading habits among users. The Library Advisory Committee ensures quality sustenance through sufficient resources and prompt services.
