6. Book caravan and reading group program

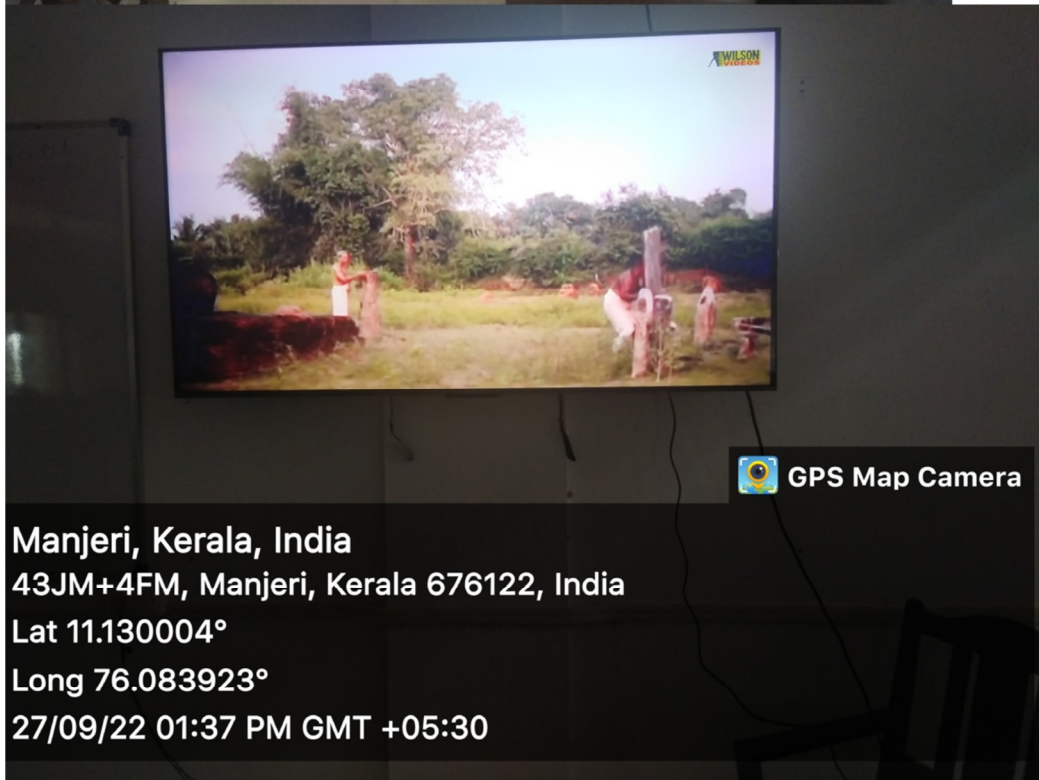
9. Film screening and discussion
