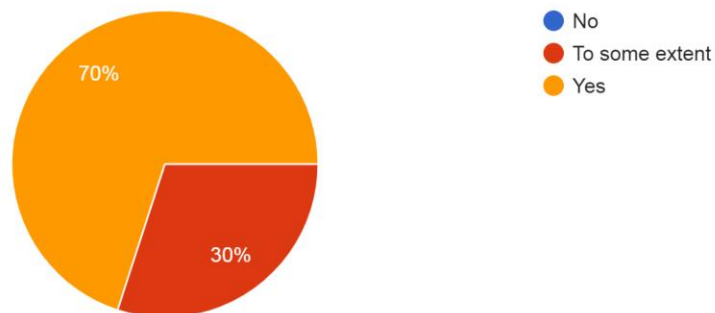

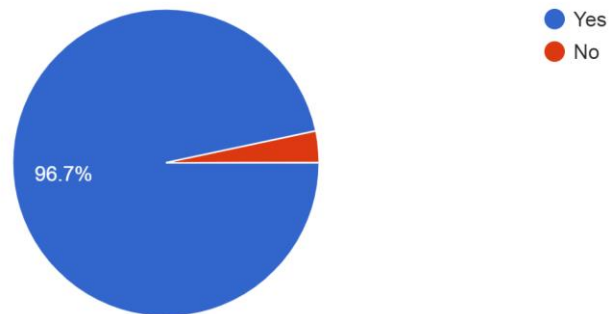
Did the speakers statement clearly supported their position in the debate

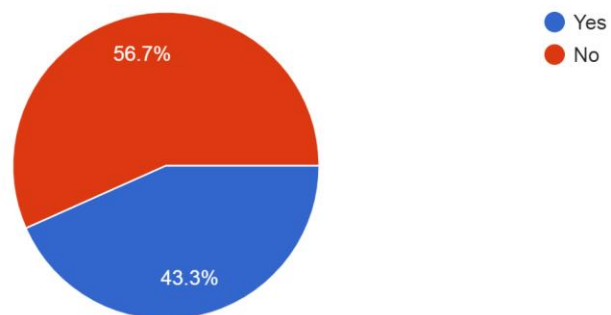
Arguments were presented with clarity and appropriate volume

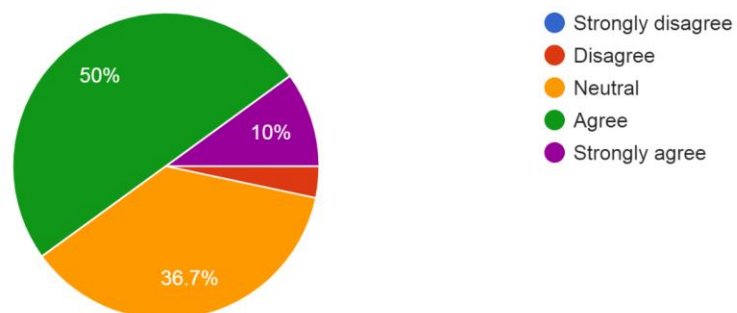
Did your opinion changed about the topic

30 responses



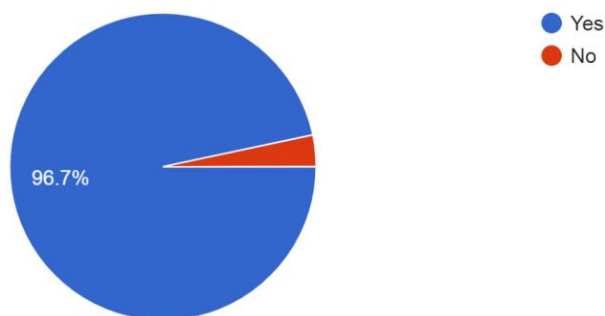
Speakers adhered to the rules of the debate
