


People's Biodiversity Register (PBR) Project

PG Department of Botany and Biodiversity Club of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, partnered with Koottilangadi Grama Panchayat, Malappuram, to prepare the People's Biodiversity Register (PBR), a project sanctioned by the Kerala State Biodiversity Board (KSBB), Thiruvananthapuram. Fifth-semester B.Sc. Botany students (2022-2025 Batch) initiated the project on 21st December 2024, collaborating with the District Coordinator of Malappuram (KSBB), Mr. Anil Pulliyil, and Panchayat members. The project aims to document the region's ecosystem diversity and compile a comprehensive inventory of its floral and faunal resources. Through active involvement, the students contributed meaningfully to biodiversity conservation while gaining valuable practical experience in ecological research and documentation. This initiative highlights the significance of community collaboration in safeguarding and sustaining natural resources for future generations.

The students also learned about the chemistry involved in testing milk for adulteration and were introduced to various other products under the Mother Dairy brand. The visit provided an enriching and exploratory learning experience, deepening their practical knowledge in the field.

Community Nutrition Camp For The Tribes At Karulai

The PG Department of Home Science successfully organized a Community Nutrition Camp as part of the curriculum, from 11th to 15th December 2024. The camp was conducted by II Semester M.Sc. Home Science (Nutrition and Dietetics) students on the topic, "Assessment of Socioeconomic Factors, Food Availability, Nutritional and Health Practices among the Tribal Population (25-65 years) of Pullivil, Karulai". The objectives of the camp were to assess the dietary intake, food availability, and health status of the tribal population. The camp was formally inaugurated by Mr. Suresh Kumar, Vice President of Pullivil panchayat. The results of the diet survey conducted among the selected tribal population indicated poor dietary practices. Also, it was observed through clinical examination that a significant part of the population exhibited signs of Vitamin A deficiency and anaemia. To address these identified nutritional problems, awareness classes and exhibition were conducted at Pulliyil Anganwadi. The sessions aimed to educate the tribal community on the importance of Vitamin A-rich foods, iron-containing foods, their sources and inclusion in daily diet for the prevention and management of these deficiencies. Additionally, personalized nutrition education sessions were conducted in each selected household to ensure better understanding and to encourage healthier nutritional practices within the community.
