Summer camp on Math Coding and AI

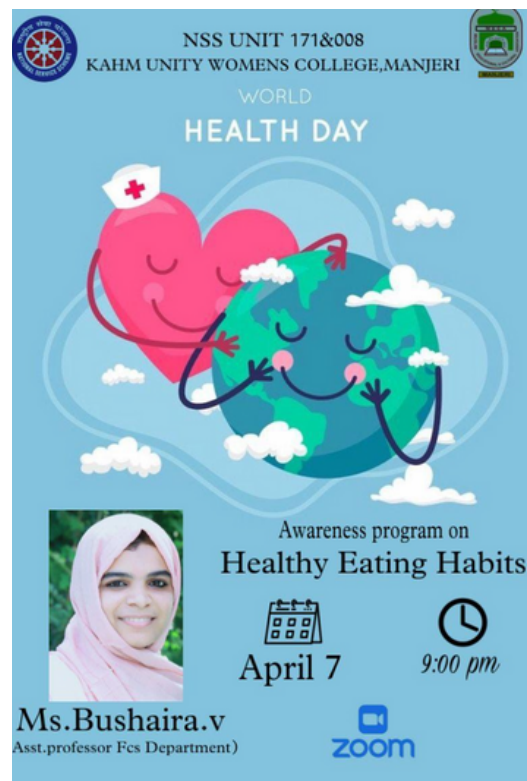

World Health Day Observed by NSS

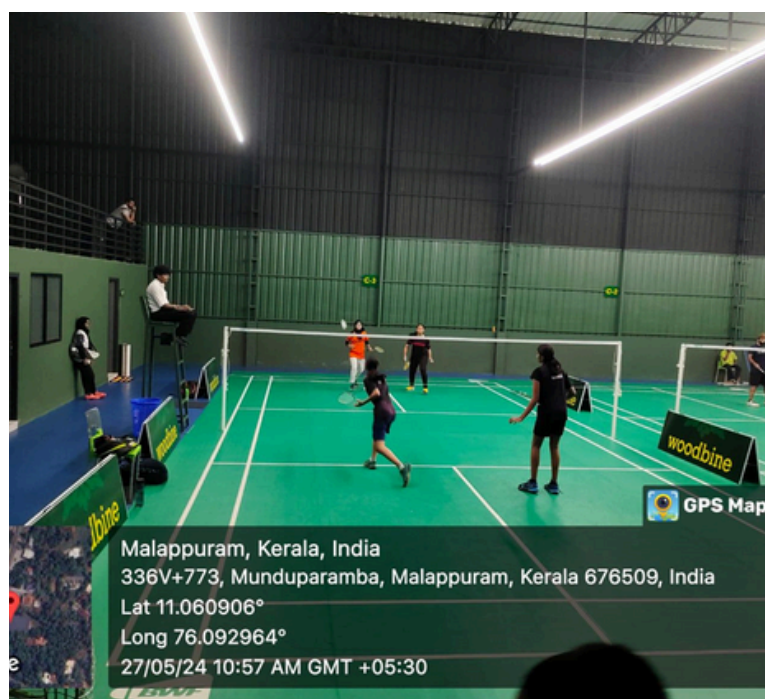

All India Ncc Girls Trekking Expedition 2024

Lt. Loosiya KP took ANO duty for the Calicut Group of the Kerala and Lakshadweep Directorate in All India NCC Girls Trekking Expedition 2024: Tamil Nadu Trek (TN Trek - I) in Nilgiris. The expedition, which included 102 cadets from the K & L Directorate was conducted by the Coimbatore Group of the Tamil Nadu, Pondicherry, and Andaman and Nicobar Directorate from May 6th to May 13th, 2024.

The trek covered a distance of approximately 60 km, spanning the following stages:

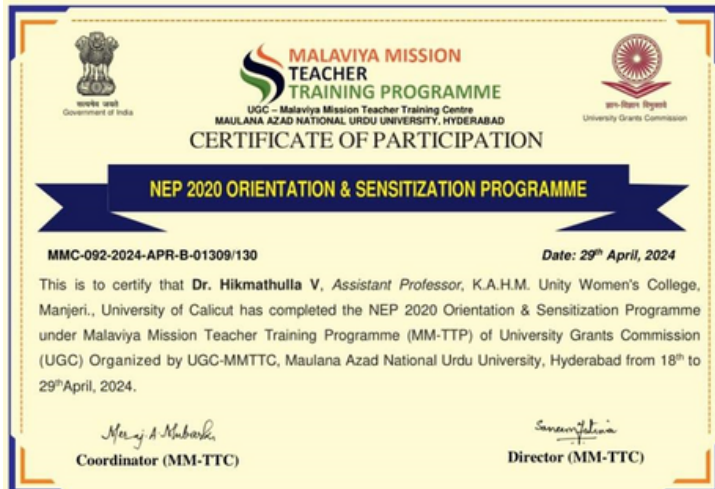

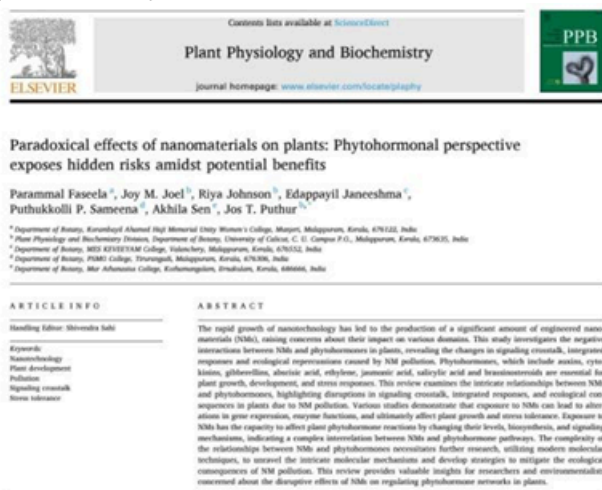
