Farewell Party for MA Batch 2020-22 by Juniors

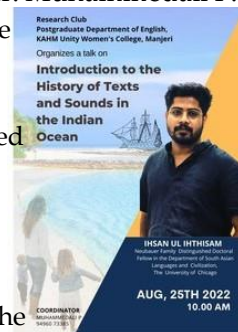

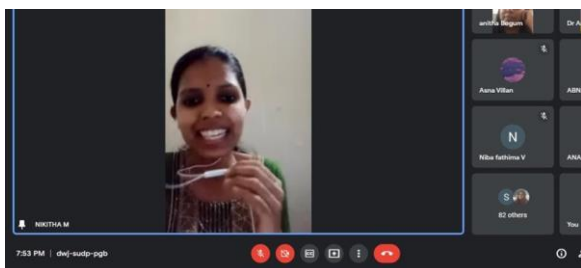
World Breastfeeding Week Celebration

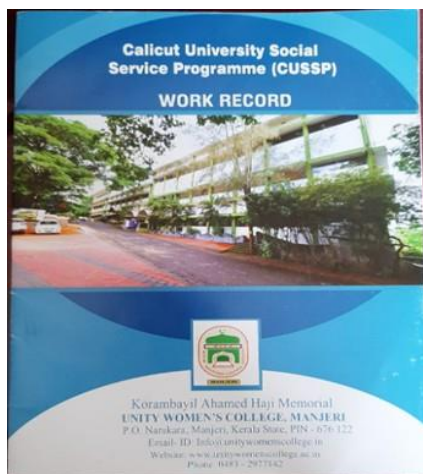
Workshop on Liquid Embroidery

Work Record Book for Calicut University Social Service Programme (CUSSP) of the College was released on 25/08/2022.

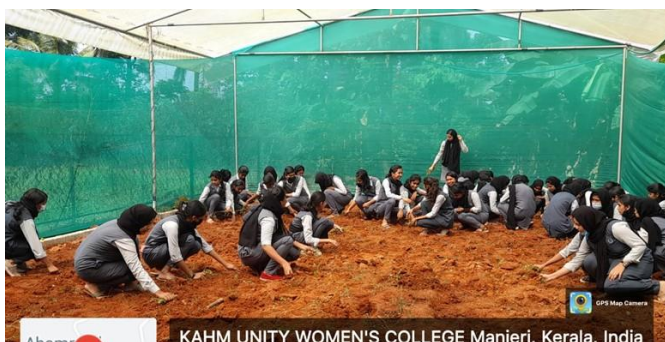

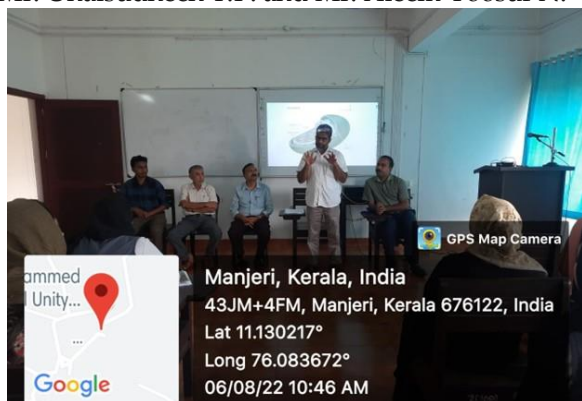
Mobile photography competition

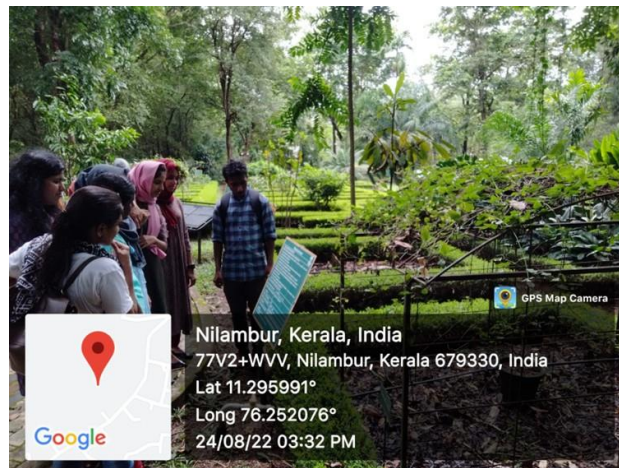


MONITEUR- Presentation Workshop Series

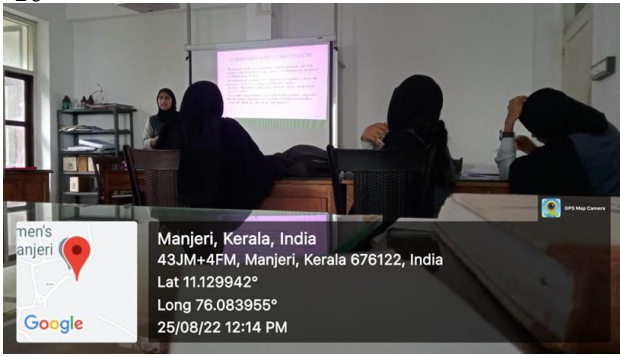
Field trip to the lap of Nilgiri hills

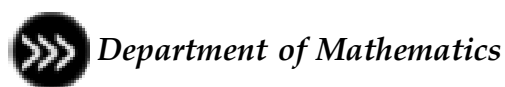
ETUDIANTS-22, Research Orientation Series

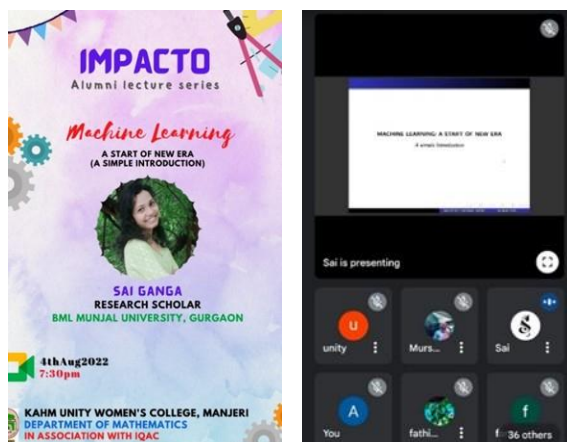


Association activities

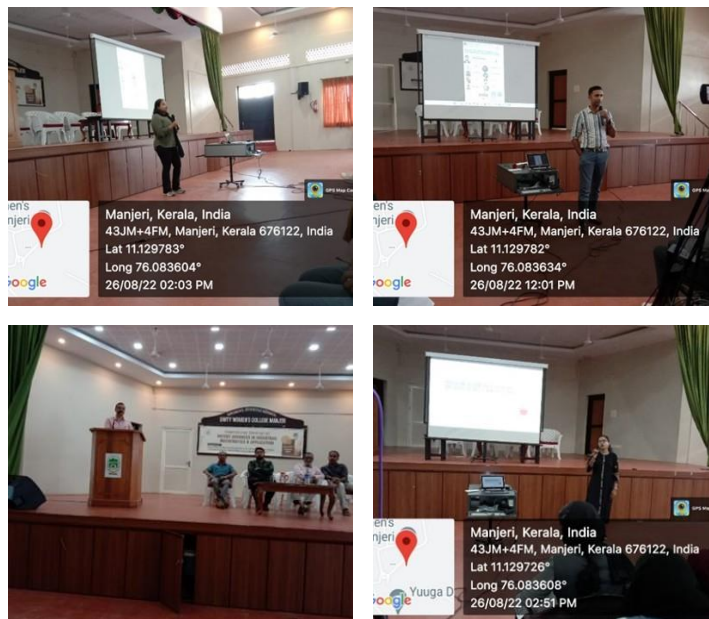
Experiential learning

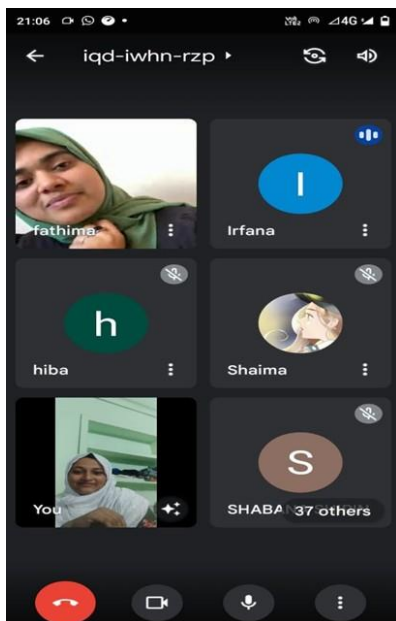
Renowned Alumni Interaction

Association Programme

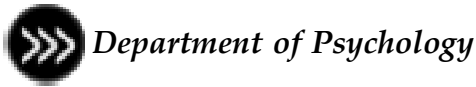

Environment Awareness Programme

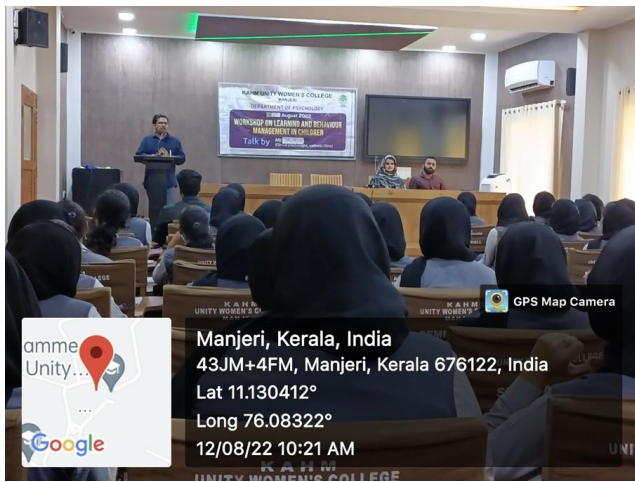

Chuvadu-A Three Day Camp

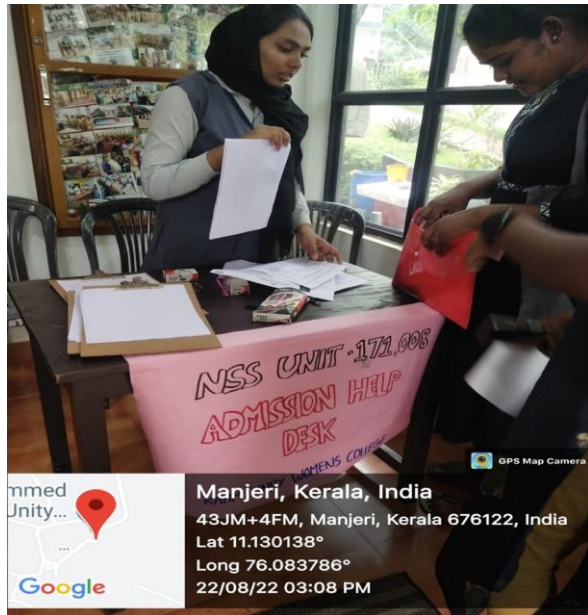

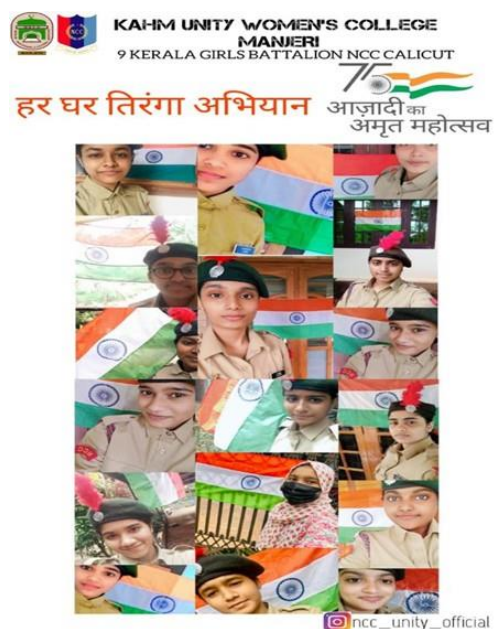


Flag Distribution

VISIT TO POOKKOTTUR WAR MEMORIAL GATE

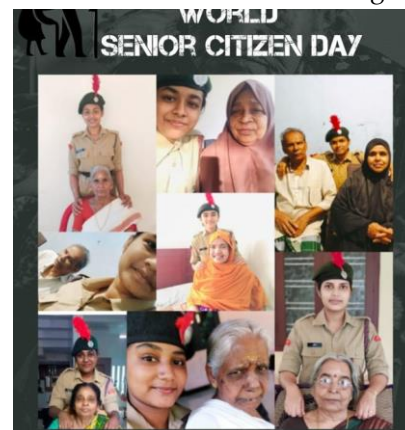

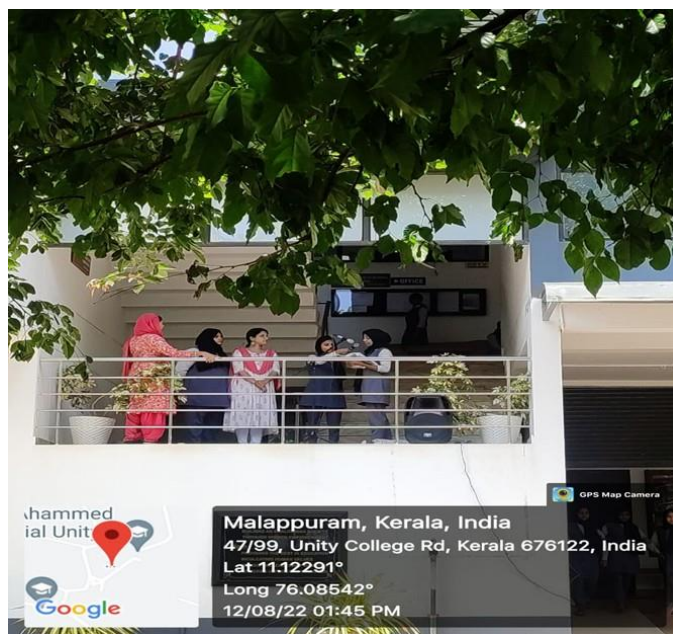
Report of PTA

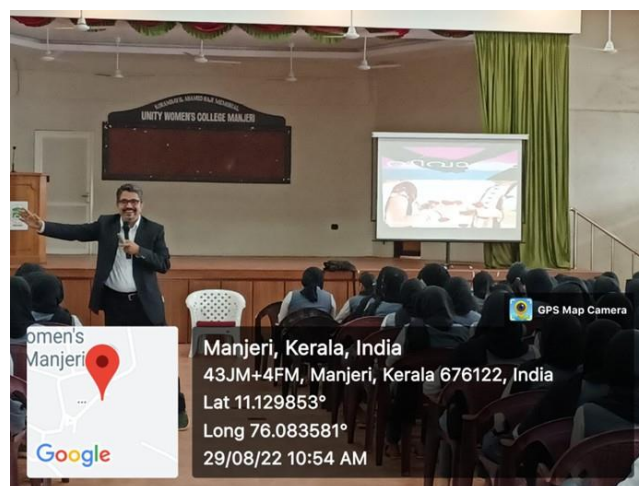

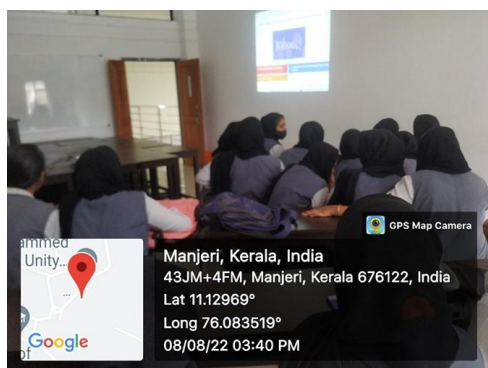

College Managing Committee Meeting was held on 19th August 2022 to discuss the developmental, curricular and co-curricular activities to be implemented in the College.

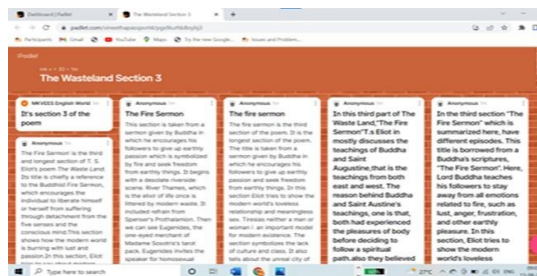


Students Achievements

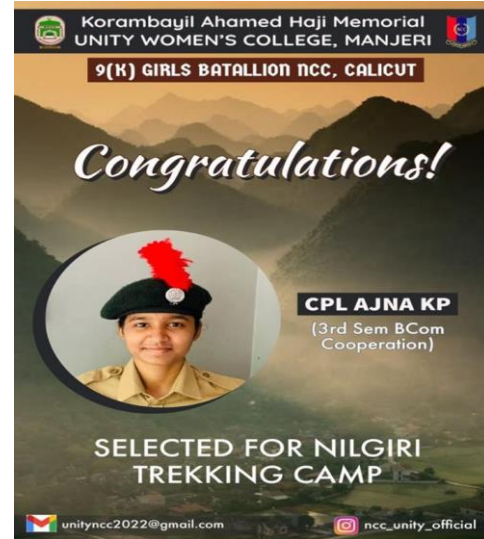

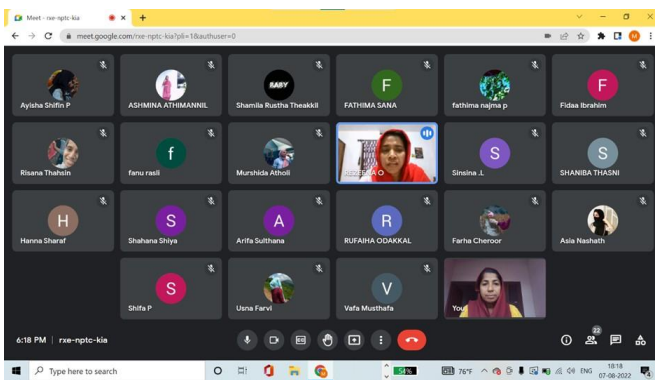
