## Workshop on Troubleshooting & Maintenance of Home Appliances

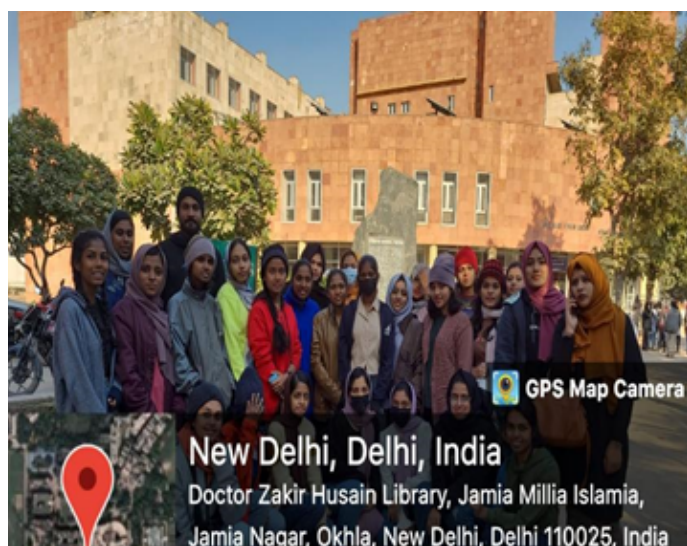

### Alumni Lecture series 5

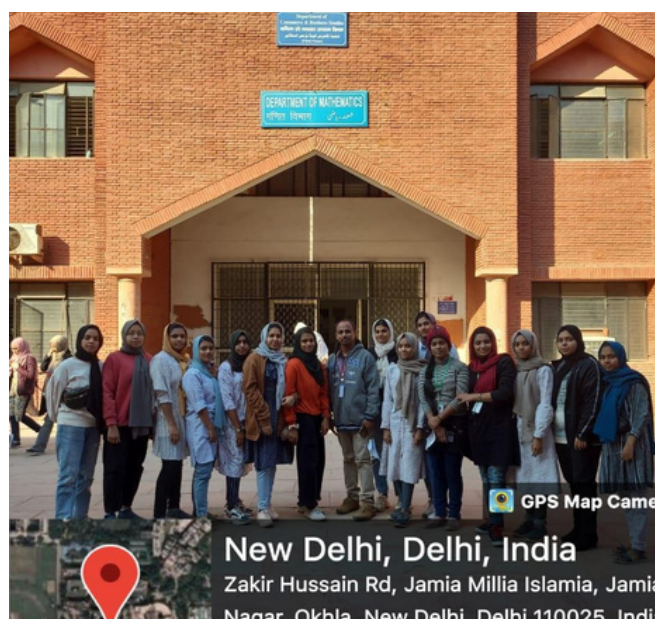

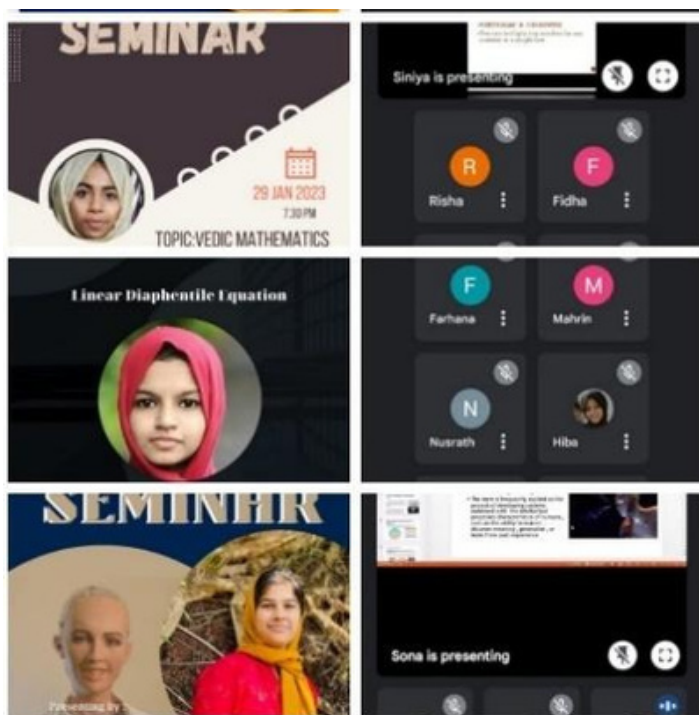
### Alumni lecture series

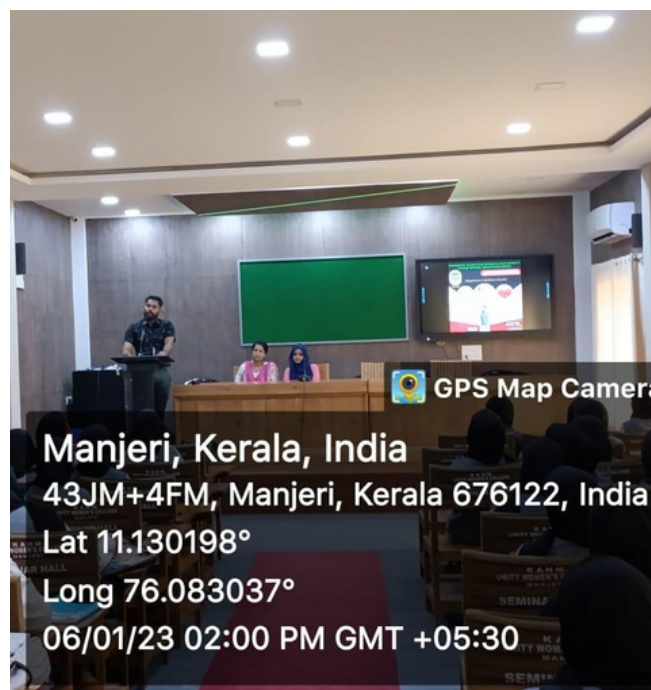
## Weekly puzzle competition

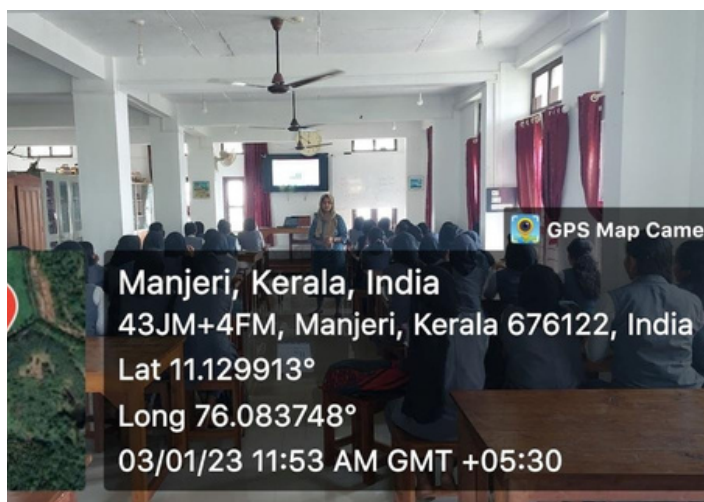
## Department of Botany

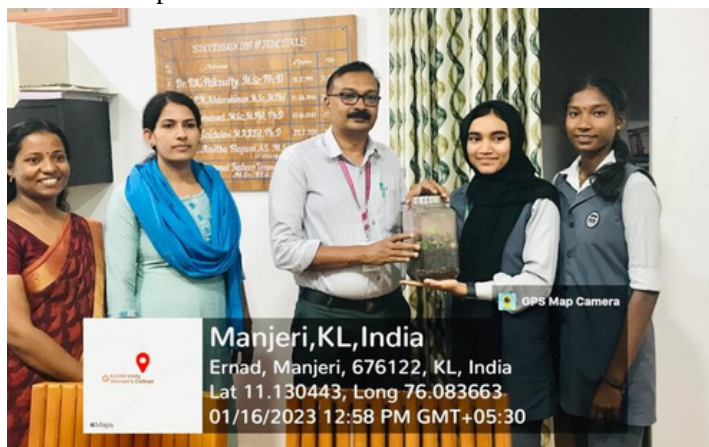
## Biostatistics Tools in Research and Data Analysis: A Training Session for Advanced Learners

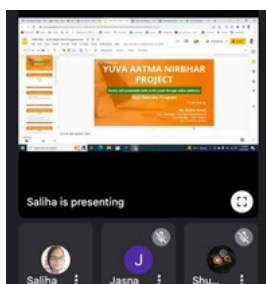
## Distribution of Micro Greens - A Community Outreach Programme

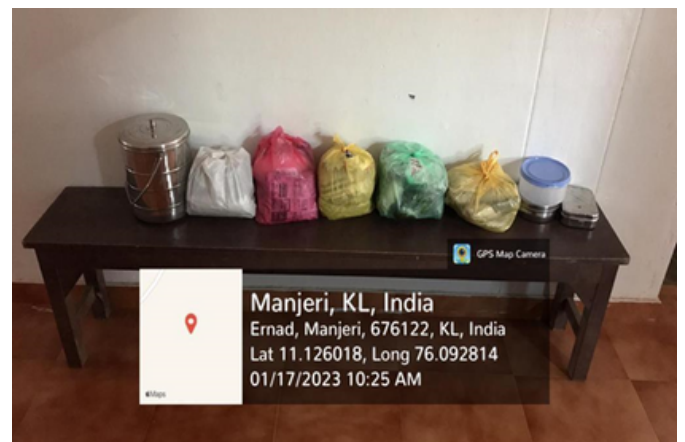
### Visit To Agri Business Incubator, Kerala Agriculture University

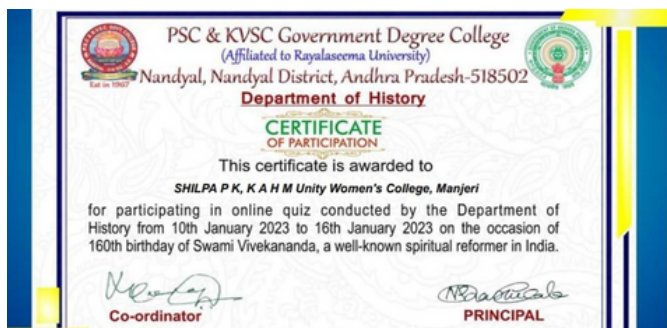

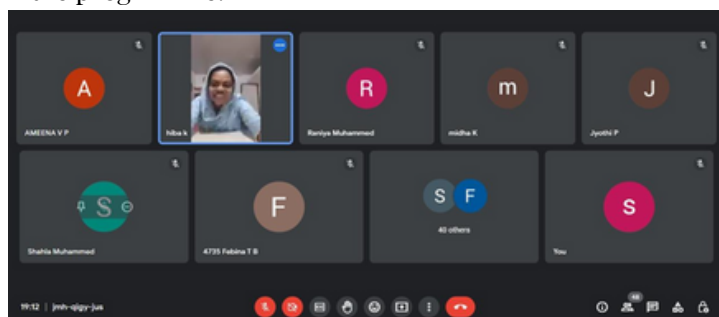
# International Seminar On Frontiers In Chemical Research
