Ensete superbum (Roxb.) Cheesman. (Kalluvazha) is a rare medicinal plant coming under the family Musaceae which possesses the seeded fruits with hard seed coat. The fruits, seeds and leaf juices are highly medicinal and commonly used to cure different human diseases. Due to the significance of plants in the Pharmaceutical industry, the plant is conserved in Biodiversity Park of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, Malappuram, Kerala. Usually, the mycorrhizal association and abiotic environmental factors induce the seed germination and seedling development in the rainy season. As part of a community outreach programme, the department distributed the fully developed E. superbum seedlings to neighboring communities on 7th July 2023. The students of Second Semester M.Sc. Botany shared the knowledge regarding medicinal properties of the distributed plants to communities. 


