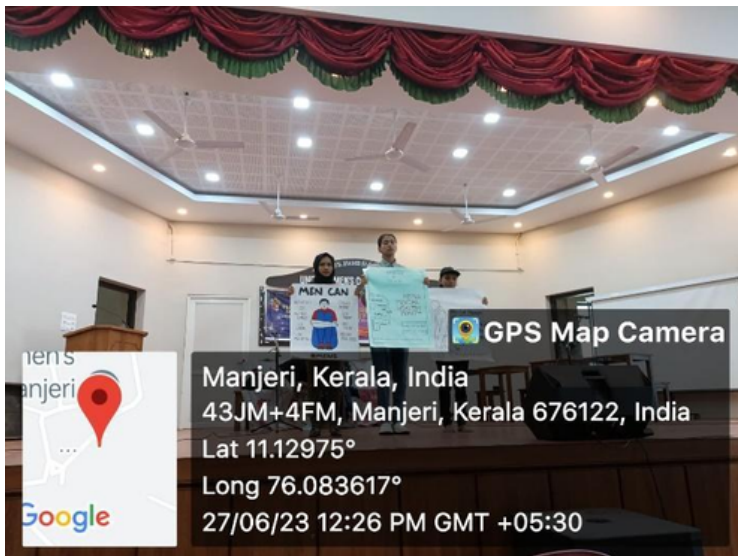
Department of Psychology

Department of Mathematics

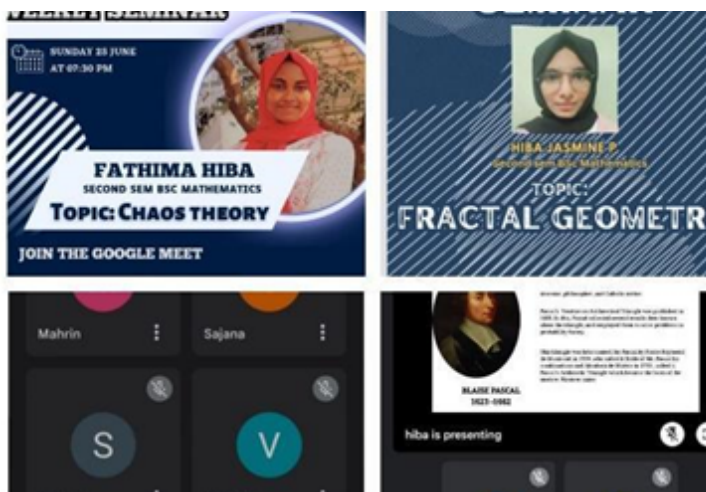
Mathematic of Environment: Poster Presentation

21 June - International Yoga Day celebration

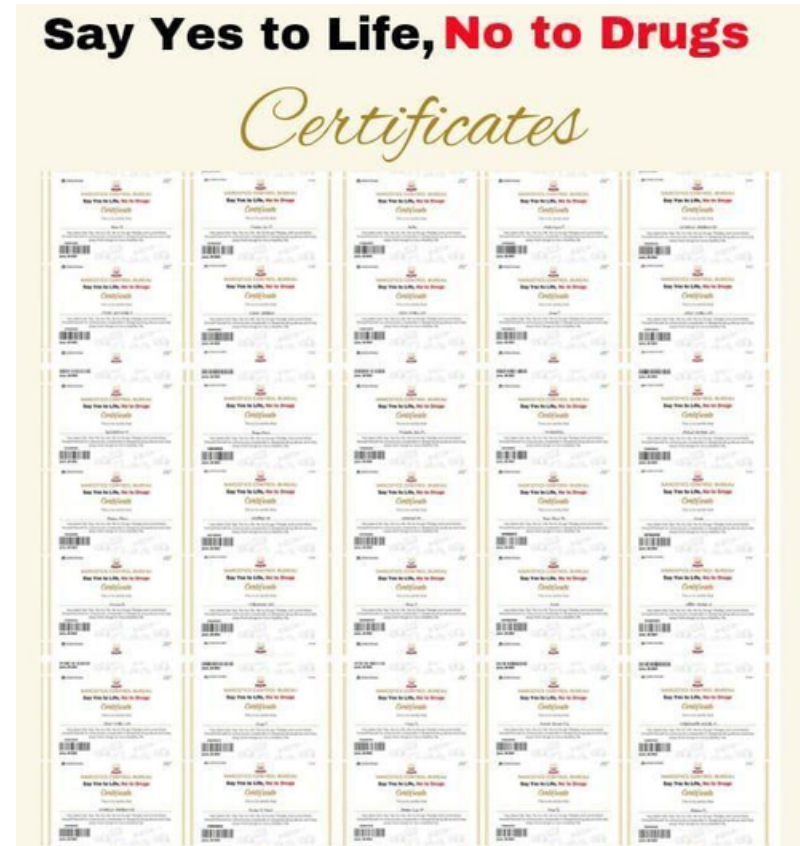
Theme: 'Yoga for Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam'

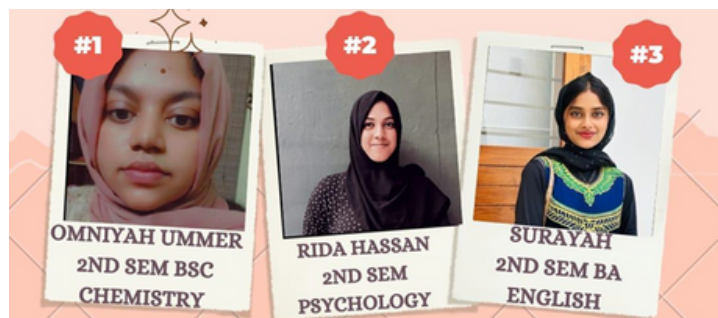

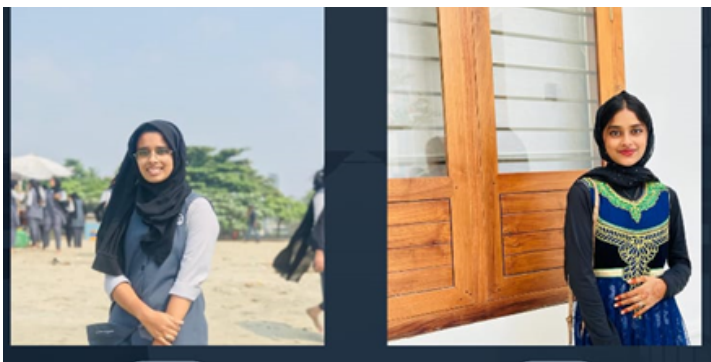

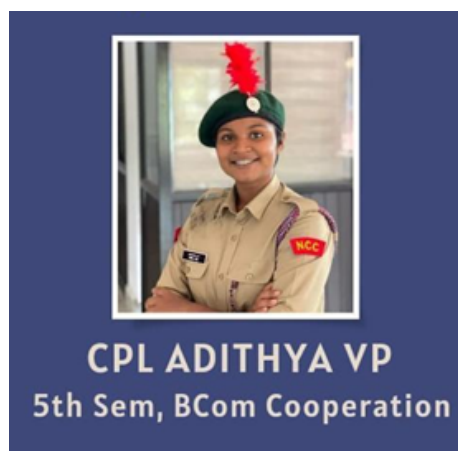
