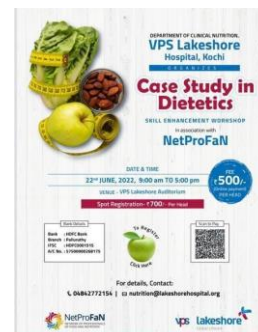


Department of Home Science

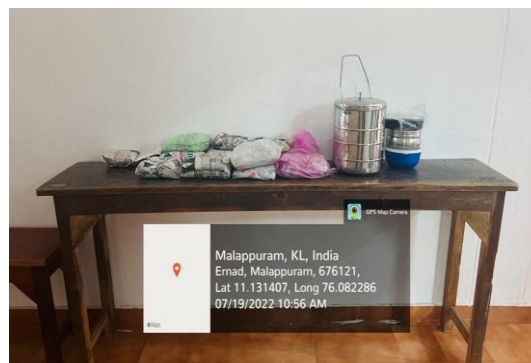
Community Intervention Programme on School Health Day

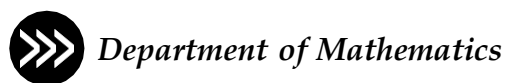
Department of Physical Education

Three Day Badminton Coaching Camp

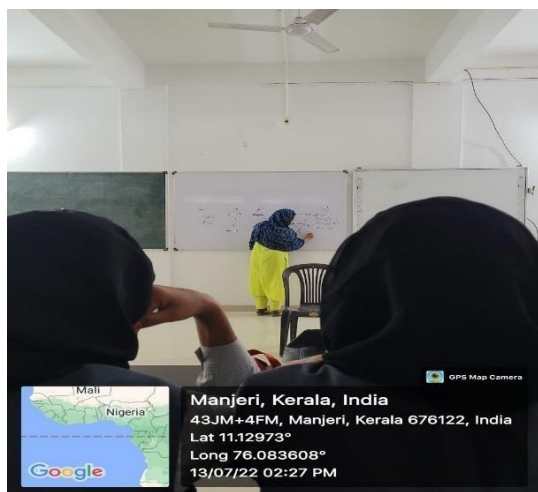

Talk on Distances in Graphs and Metric Dimension



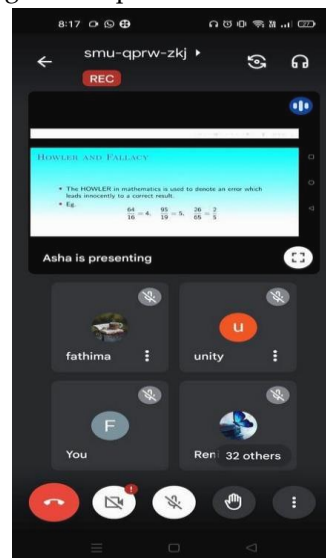

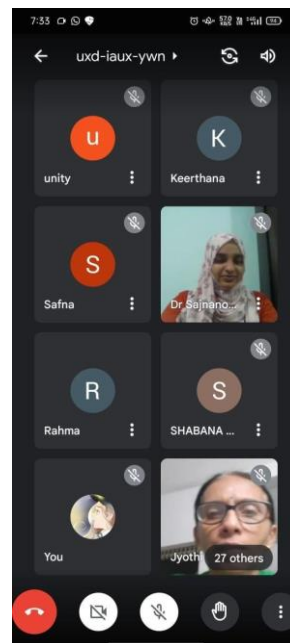
Programmes

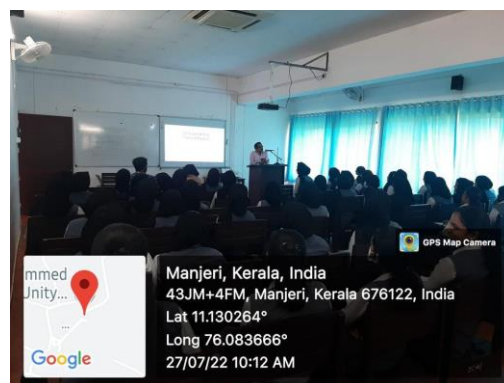
Department of History

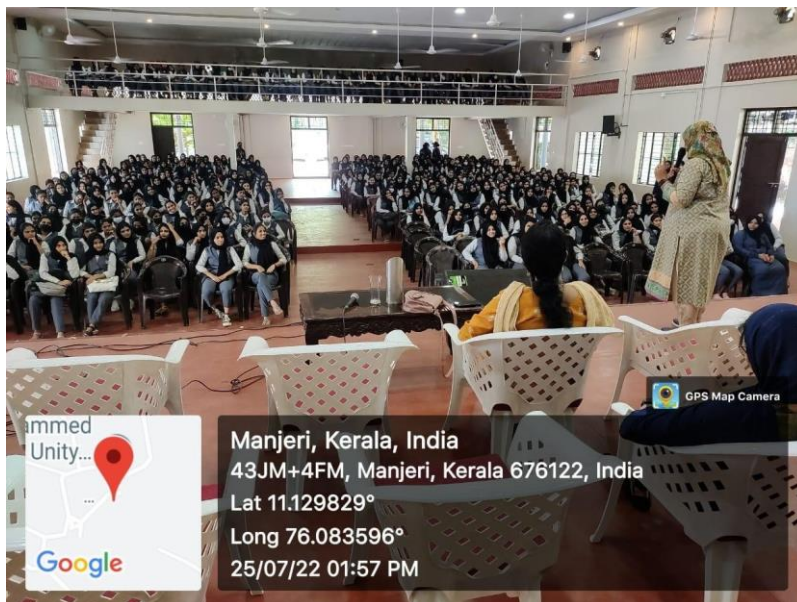

Lecture on Personal Growth: 'You Have a Choice' by Shaida Ashraf:

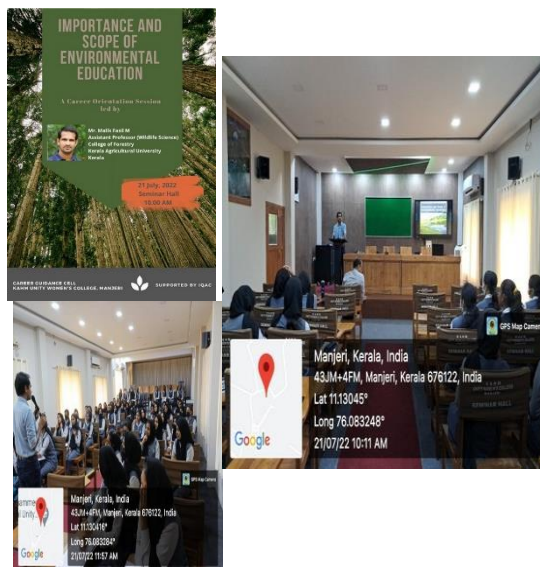

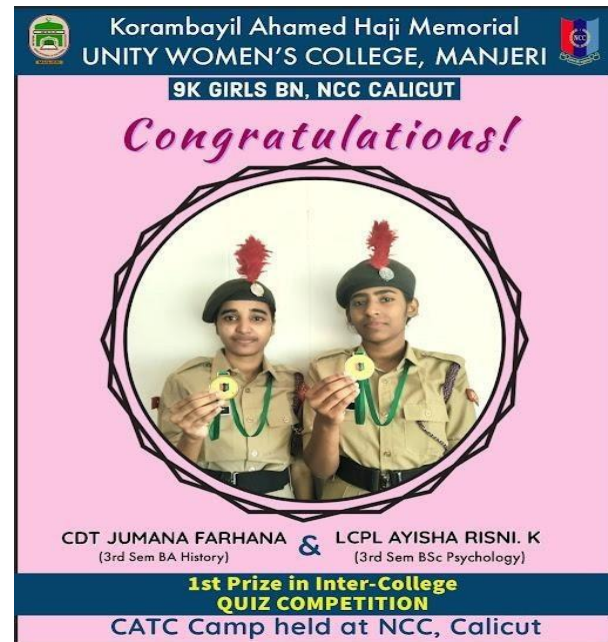


English Oppana Team: II Place, Bakrid Fest

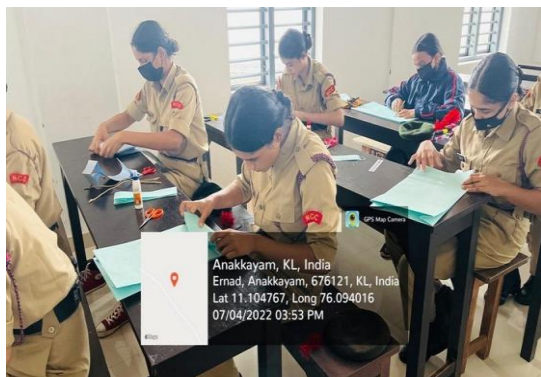

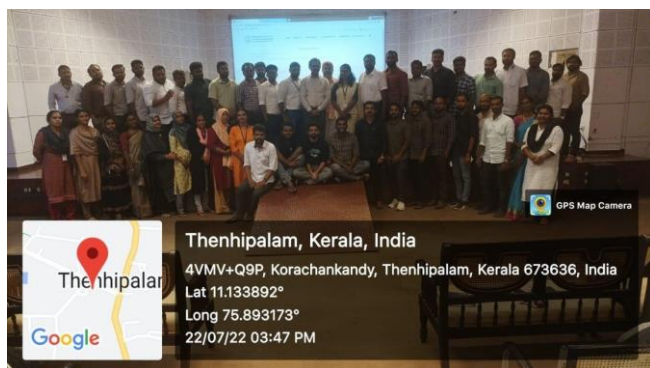


Study Camp

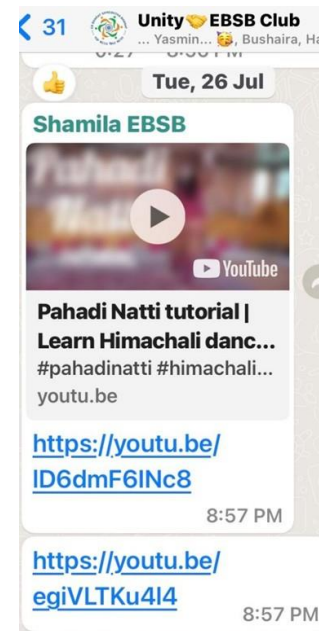
Lunar Show

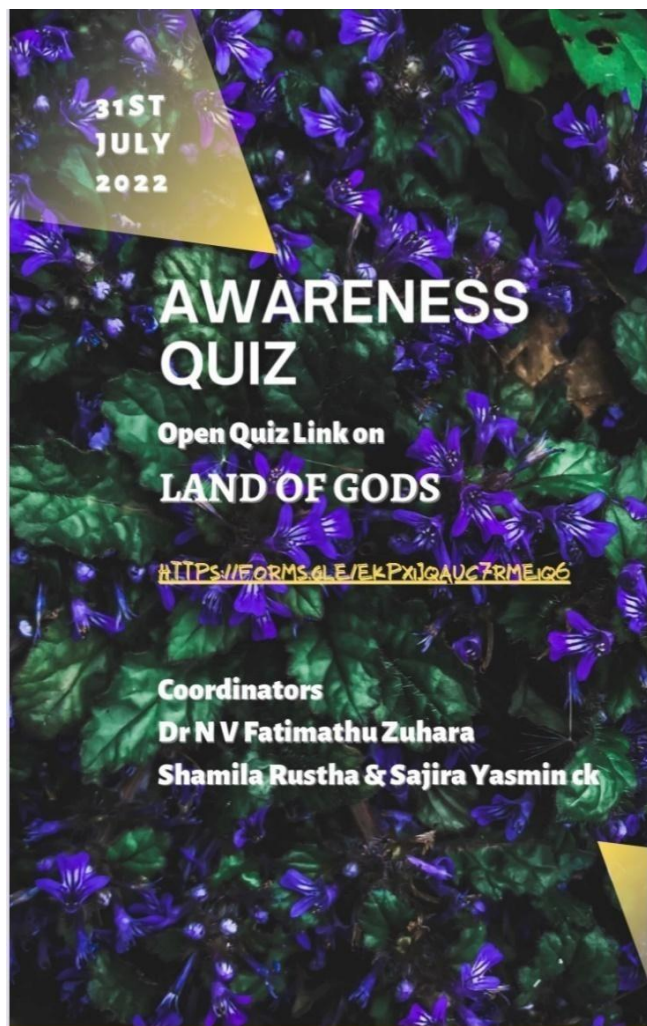


Learning Pahadi Natti

Open Link Awareness Quiz on 'Land of Gods'

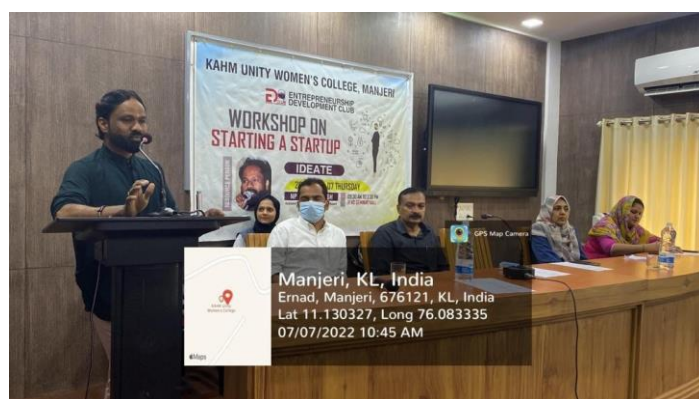
