## Algen 2023: Algal Collection Trip to Thikkodi, Kozhikode

Algae, a diverse group of simple, plant-like organisms that range in size from microscopic single cells to giant seaweeds. play a variety of important roles in the environment and in human society. To understand more about the marine algal diversity, the PG Department of Botany conducted an algal collection trip to Thikkodi, Kozhikode on 11th November 2023 for First Semester M.Sc. # Organic Univegetable Garden 2023

On 21st November 2023, organic farming was restarted (Organic Univegetable Garden) with the objective of giving students first-hand experience with nature and gardening by providing a phase of manual training on the usage of tools and implements in the gardening processes together with the preparation of cultivating soil. Dr. Usman A. (Head of the Department) inaugurated the experiential learning event by planting the Tomato seedling in the organic cultivating area of Polyhouse that was purchased from Daliya Nursery and Garden, Anakkayam, Manjeri. As per the advice provided by the gardener, First Semester B.Sc. Botany students helped to prepare the cultivating area and planted the vegetable seedlings viz. Lycopersicum esculentum, Capsicum annuum, Abelmoschus esculentus and Vigna unguiculata properly in the drip irrigated site.



#### Dig into dirt - Worms at work

A hands-on training workshop on 'Worm Farming & Vermicomposting' was organized for the First Semester B.Sc. Botany students on 21st November 2023 to inculcate concepts of vermicomposting, a process based on earthworms and microorganisms whose joint action provides degradation and detoxification of organic waste as well as conversion into a product to be used for agronomic purposes. Dr. Usman A. (Head of the Department) inaugurated the extension activity related program and demonstrated the basic steps of vermicomposting including vermibed preparation, substrate application, stocking of earthworms, worm feeding and vermicast harvesting. During the second session, the students constructed the compost unit using the essentials of procedure (Coconut husk, Cow dung, Earth worm and Organic waste) to compost organic wastes not only for the disposal of solid organic wastes but also to produce superior quality manure for feeding our nutrient hungry soils. The experiential learning provided needed information and guidance to start and flourish vermicompost technology in future and the event concluded with the vote of thanks delivered by Dr. Deepa P. (Assistant Professor Adhoc).

# Hands-on Training Workshop on Plant Tissue Culture Technique

The Department organized 'Hands-on Training Workshop on Plant Tissue Culture Technique' on 21st& 22nd November 2023 to familiarize fundamental laboratory setup and micropropagation procedure needed for in vitro plant regeneration. The coordinator welcomed the gathering in which thirty-two M.Sc. Botany students participated and experienced the vocational training event. The facilities, requirements, abiotic conditions and protocols needed for a whole plant in vitro regeneration from the explant tissue had been conveyed to the students by the resource person during the first day and prepared the culture media for inoculation process. On 22nd November 2023, the surface sterilized explants inoculated into the media and incubated in the culture room with controlled light and temperature to regenerate plantlets. After providing a clear knowledge on acclimatization and practicing the steps of hardening, the certificates were distributed to the participants and concluded the program with the vote of thanks delivered by Adila Nasrin, Student Coordinator, Third Semester M.Sc. Botany.

# Hands-on training workshop on Microbiology Techniques

'Ambrosia' Research Club, Department of Botany conducted a four-day handson training workshop on Microbiology techniques in collaboration with Geno Bio Research Centre, Kottakkal on 28-30th November and 1st December 2023. The program aimed to provide participants with practical insights into key aspects of microbiology. 30 students from 1st semester MSc students actively participated in the program. Mr. Mohammed Musthafa E.P., Supervising Guide. Geno Bio Research Centre and Dr. Faseela P., Assistant Professor, Dept. of Botany shared theoretical as well as practical insights and guided participants in microbiology techniques. The participants also explored the isolation of bioactive compounds from selected plant extracts and engaged in evaluating the antimicrobial activity of selected plant extracts towards the selected microorganisms. 
#### World Diabetes Day Celebrateion

## Alumni Lecture Series Season 2 – Lecture 5 on "Experience Agile Scrum & Testing Approaches".




