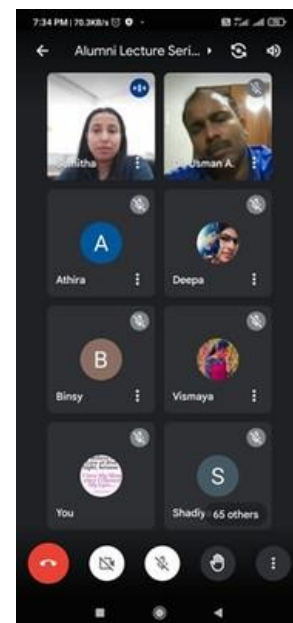
Mentee scholar series II : 'An Introduction to the Embryology of Angiosperms'

- iii) Mathematics of satellite launching



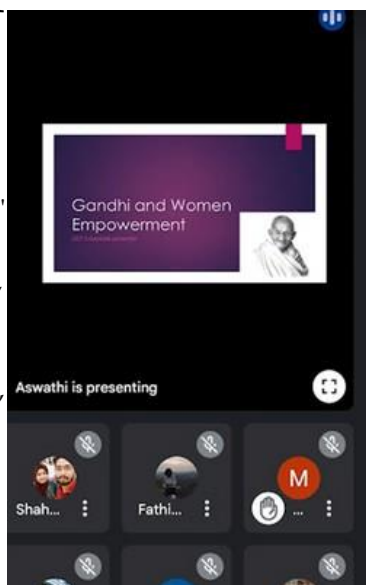
Department of History

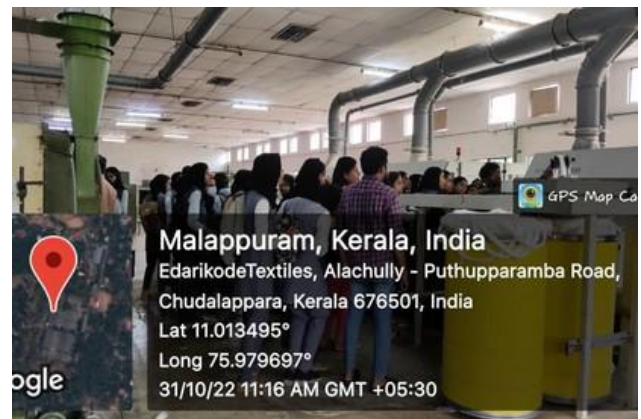
Motivational Talk

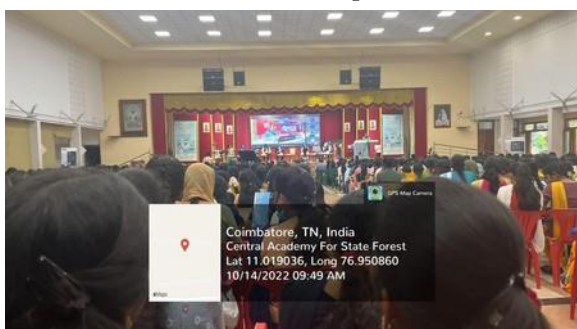
Extension Activity C Mae Talk - Breast Cancer Awareness C Medical Camp

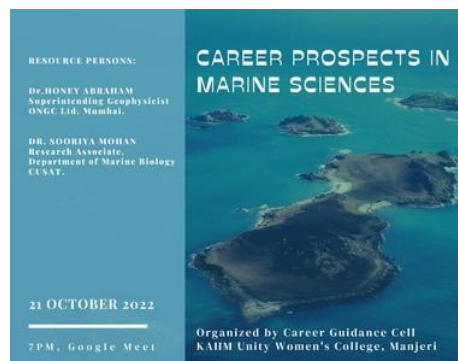

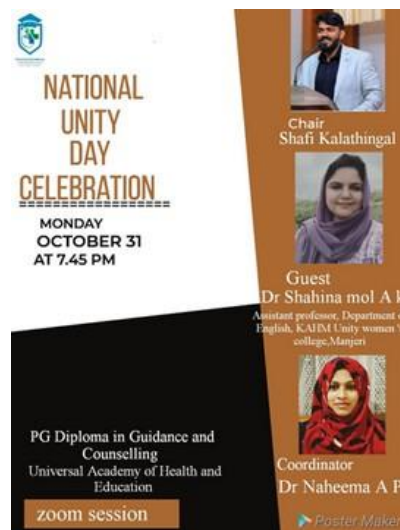

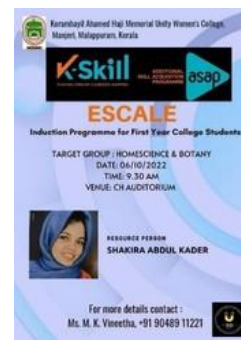

Fund Collection For Snehabhavanam 2022-23

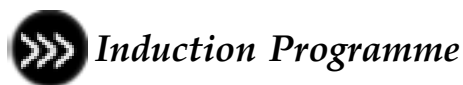

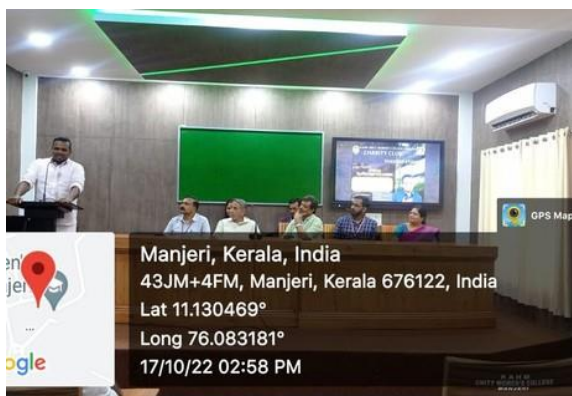

Campus Radio: Voice of Unity, An Initiative of Women Cell

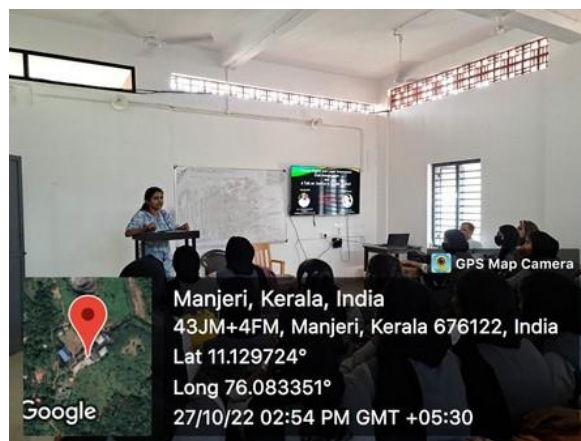
