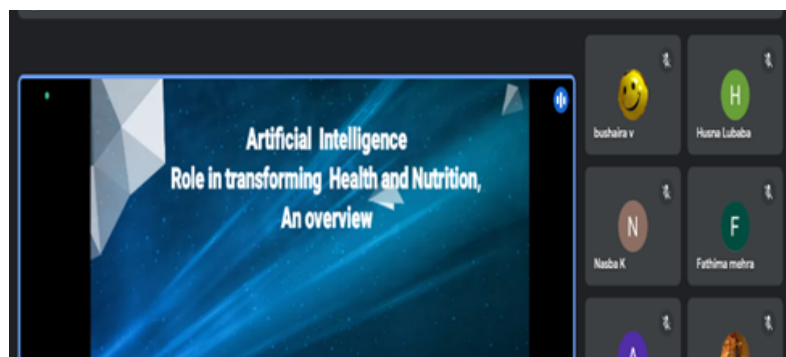
World Aids Day Celebration

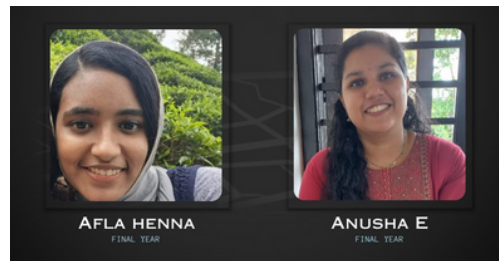

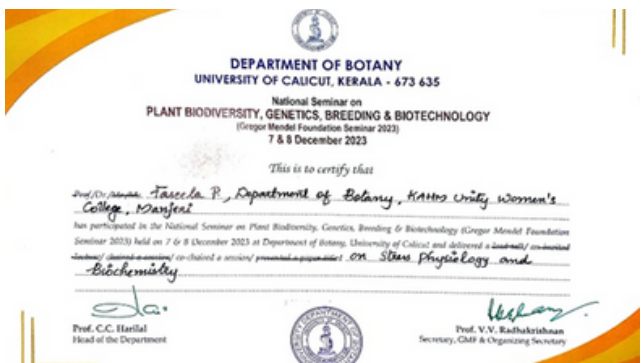

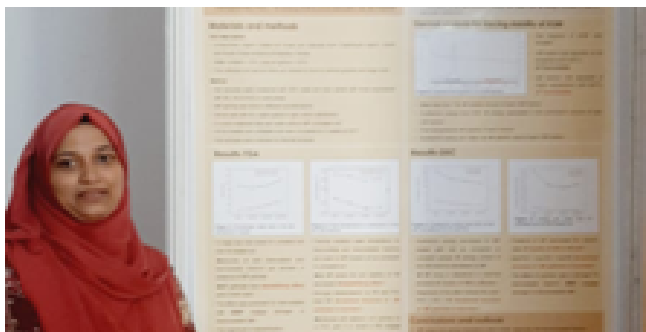
