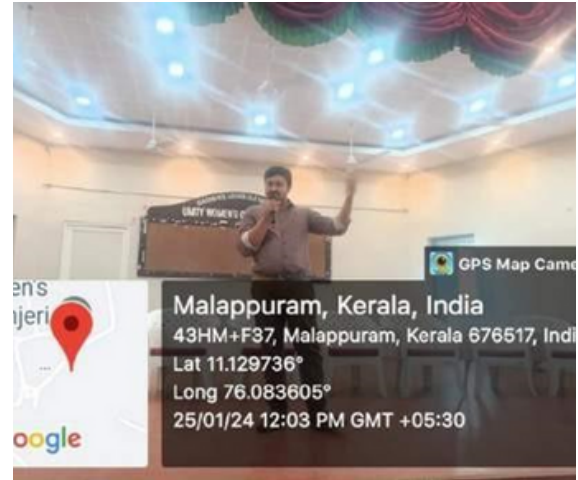

## Two-day nature education camp and Brahmagiri peak trekking

The Eco & Nature Club organized a two-day nature education camp and Brahmagiri peak trekking event at Thirunelli forest division in Wayanad on January 13th and 14th, 2024. On the inaugural day, participants immersed themselves in nature with a visit to the Kalindhi River, an insightful nature class, and a documentary by wildlife expert Mr. Muneer Tholpetty, focusing on the majestic elephants inhabiting the region. The day culminated in an engaging quiz competition, won by Mrs. Asna Jahan, a 1st-semester BSc Botany student. Day two began with an early morning bird-watching session led by Mr. Nandu, the Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) of Thirunelli Forest Division. Participants observed a diverse array of bird species. The highlight of the event was the challenging 12-kilometer Brahmagiri peak trek guided by dedicated forest guards. Along the trek, participants encountered various plant species and the endemic Shola-grassland forest ecosystem. The trek concluded at the breathtaking peak at 1608 meters above sea level, providing participants with a sense of accomplishment and stunning panoramic views of the Kudak and Wayanad border. A total of 42 students from various departments actively participated in the program. The participants observed various wildlife animals, including leopards. The camp and trekking were coordinated by Dr. Faseela P and Mrs. Shifa M (Assistant Professors, Department of Botany), along with Mrs. Niranjana (1st Sem BSc Maths) and Mrs. Zeva Khan (1st Sem BSc Botany).
