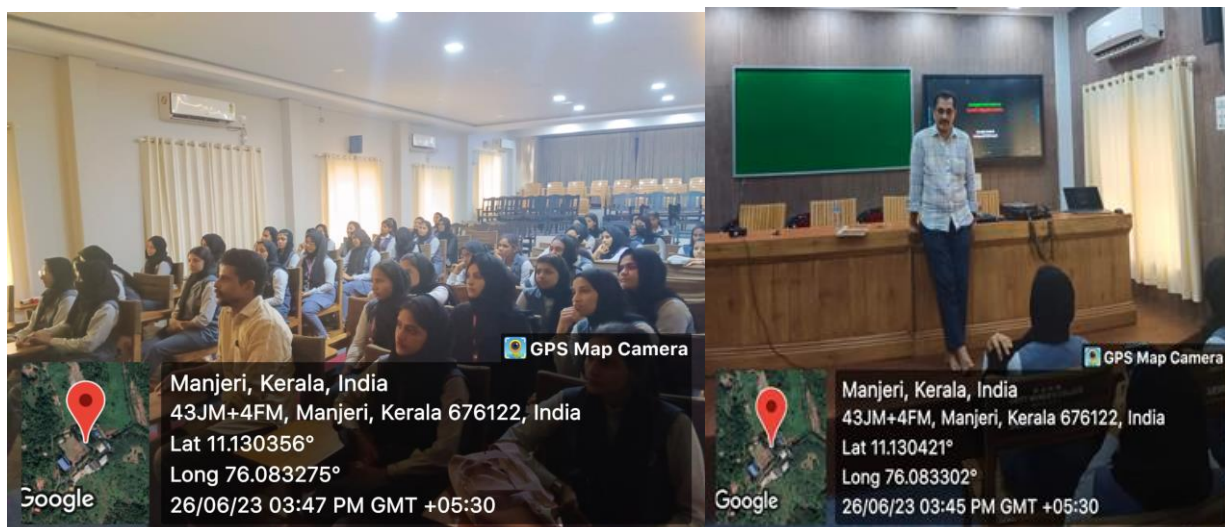

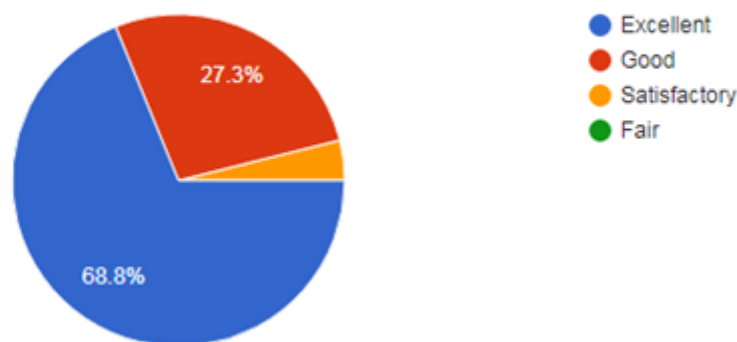

Continuous monitoring and evaluation are essential to refining the program and ensuring sustained positive outcomes over time.

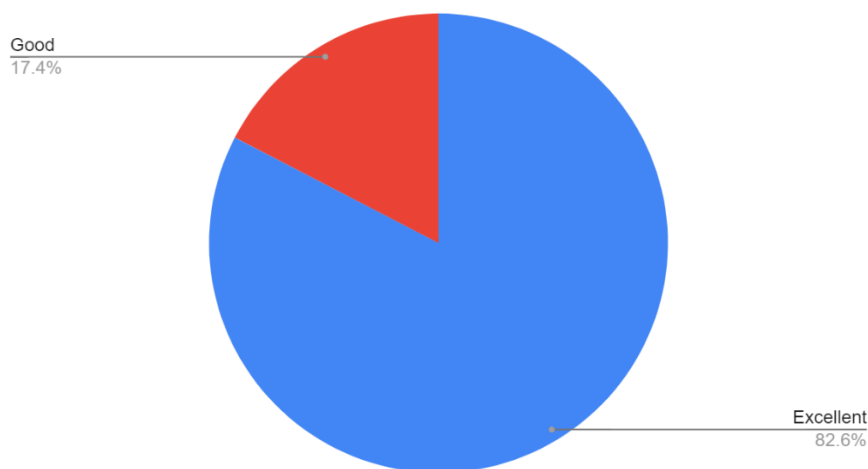
