### **Activities of Literary Club -2023-2024**

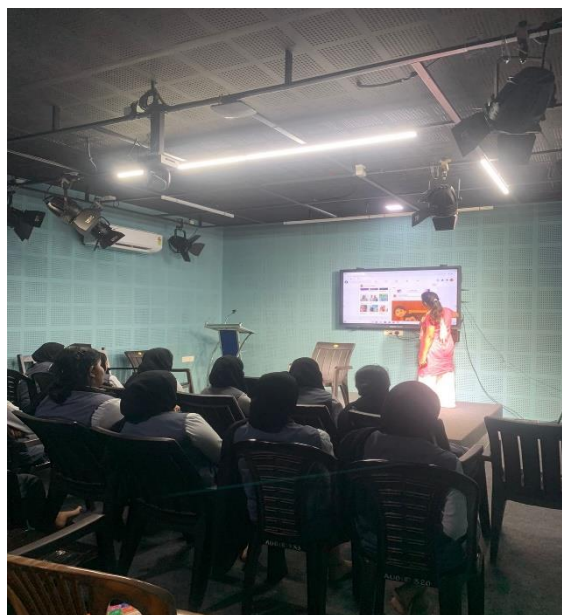
#### **Activity 1**
