

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I. HISTORY OF THE INSTITUTION

Malappuram – the district in which the college is located has a long and profound history in the country's freedom struggle in the Malabar region. As an expression of apathy to the foreign rule, people of this region turned away from all that were British and the heavy price that had to be paid for this was the socio-educational progress.

Location:

The college is located at 'Koodakkara', in the Pulpatta Grama Panchayath of Ernad Taluk, Malappuram District, Kerala. It is situated 45 Kms. south of Calicut (=Kozhikode) city, 20 Kms. away from Calicut Airport, 5 Kms. west of Manjeri and 1.6 Kms. off Manjeri – Calicut Trunk road.

About the college:

Established on 18th December 1991 as a first grade college and affiliated to University of Calicut, the institution is run by a Registered Society viz. Muslim Educational and Cultural Association (MECA). The college was inaugurated by revered Panakkad Syed Muhammed Ali Shihab Thangal in a simple but august function presided by (Late) Korambayil Ahamed Haji M.P in the presence of Dr. T.K Ravindran, the then Vice Chancellor of Calicut University.

It has the unique distinction of being the first college in Kerala started without Pre Degree course, the only Women's College in the district and the only multi faculty Women's College run by the Muslim Community in Kerala.

At the time of inception, the college functioned in a rented building (owned by Late Subedar Krishnan Panicker) at 'Alukkal' near Narukara. Subsequently, to facilitate operational smoothness, the college was shifted during 1992 – '93 to Kacherippady in Manjeri town. Finally, the college moved to its present and permanent campus at Koodakkara in 1996 and obtained UGC recognition in 1998.

Unity College with its humble beginning with 3 courses and 32 students has positioned today as a reputed centre of higher education offering 9 courses, 800 plus students, 43 teachers and 26 ministerial staff within a relatively short time span of 12 years.

The college celebrated its 10th Anniversary during 2001 - '02.
