

COURSE DESCRIPTION.

Ornamentation of fabrics have been practiced for as long as fabrics themselves have been used. Embroidery is a method of ornamentation of a fabric achieved by stitching design on it with a needle and thread. Hand embroidery is a dynamic subject that opens up a wide range of career opportunities.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To understand what embroidery is.
- 2. To know about the different materials and tools required for embroidery.
- 3. Master basic embroidery and stitch techniques.
- 4. Align embroidery and stitch design with personal fashion practice.
- 5. Develop design in relation to fashion, embroidery and stitch.

Unit 1

Introduction to embroidery. Importance of traditional embroideries in India.

Unit 2

Identification of various hand embroidery techniques in India – chinkankari, kantha, phulkari, mirror work, aari work and zardozi.

Unit 3

Tools and materials for different types of embroidery. – dress makers shears, table stand, ruler, small pointed scissors, embroidery frame, thimble, needles, cruel embroidery needles, needle threader, punch needles, measuring tape, pinking shears, thread nippers, pin cushion, seam ripper, tweezers, embroidery thread, embroidery fabric, iron and ironing board.

(3hrs)

Practicals

1. Carry out the following stitches

Running stitch, back stitch, straight stitch, French knot, stem stitch, chain stitch, satin stitch, feather stitch, split stitch, lazy daisy stitch, fly stitch, woven wheel stitch, French knot, seed stitch, herringbone stitch, couching, blanket stitch, bullion knot and straight stitch.

(6 hrs)

2. Mirror work, Kantha work and Applique work.

(5 hrs)

3. Tracing design on the material to be embroidered.

(2hrs)

- 4. Selecting appropriate needle and thread for the type of embroidery to be carried out according to the texture of the material. (1hr)
- 5. Identifying colour combination and usage of thread as per the design selected and completing the design with the appropriate stitches.

(5hrs)

6. Submission of an embroidered household linen or dress.

(4hrs).
