Report on the Construction of Sneha Bhavanam 2 at Korambail Ahmed Haji Memorial Unity Women's College

Introduction:

The Sneha Bhavanam 2 project was initiated as part of the NSS units of Korambail Ahmed Haji Memorial Unity Women's College to provide a home for a homeless classmate. The project was incorporated into the Vision@30 project formulated by the management as part of the college's thirtieth anniversary celebrations.

Aim:

The primary aim of this project was to provide a home for a homeless classmate in need. Additionally, the project aimed to foster unity and compassion among students by working together towards a common cause.

Objectives:

To select a deserving homeless student in need of a home.

To raise funds through contributions from students, staff, and well-wishers.

To collect construction materials through donations from local residents and parents.

To complete the construction of the house on time with the help of a reliable construction company.

To ensure that the project is completed within the allocated budget.

Methodology:

The project committee was constituted on 28 September 2022, with the Principal Dr. Muhammad Basheer Ummatur as Chairman and Engineer O. Abdul Ali as President and Manager. Dr. Hikmatullah V served as the General Convener, and Muhammad Abdul Hakeem C. as Secretary, Kannian Muhammadali as Treasurer, Dr. Jasna VC as Fund Collection Coordinator, and Hamraz Ahmed M as Construction Coordinator Adv. Abdurrahiman Karat, Dr. Shahinamol AK, Dr. Abdussalam, Mrs. Lucia, and Adam Tanari served as members.

Applications were invited from students to find a deserving homeless student, and one most deserving student was selected out of the three applications received. NSS volunteers distributed coupons for fundraising, and each student contributed as much as they could. Fundraising began on October 18, 2022, and payments began on November 25, 2022. In addition, many construction materials were donated by well-meaning locals and parents. A total of 1041370 rupees were collected, out of which 925474 rupees were spent on the construction of the house. The remaining 115896 rupees were allocated for the next Sneha Bhavanam project.

Engineer Muhammadali Cherani and his construction company were appointed for the construction of the house, and construction work commenced on 10 December 2022. The entire work was completed on 14 March 2023, within the allocated budget.

Conclusion:

The Sneha Bhavanam 2 project was successfully completed, providing a home for a homeless classmate. The project committee, students, parents, NSS volunteers, teaching and non-teaching staff, and well-wishers all contributed towards this great cause. We hope that this project will not only provide a home for a homeless classmate but also promote unity and compassion among students. We extend our heartfelt thanks to everyone who contributed towards this project.





















