COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course provides clear understanding of causes, diagnosis, symptoms, and criteria of disorders. The course "Case Analysis in Psychology" typically focuses on examining and analysing real-life cases within the field of psychology. Students learn to apply psychological theories, principles, and research findings to understand and interpret complex cases. Emphasis is often placed on critical thinking, problem-solving, and ethical considerations in analysing case studies. Topics may include clinical assessments, treatment interventions, ethical dilemmas, cultural considerations, and professional guidelines. Students are expected to develop skills in case conceptualization, hypothesis testing, and formulating evidence-based recommendations. Assignments may involve case presentations, written analyses, group discussions, and role-playing exercises.
