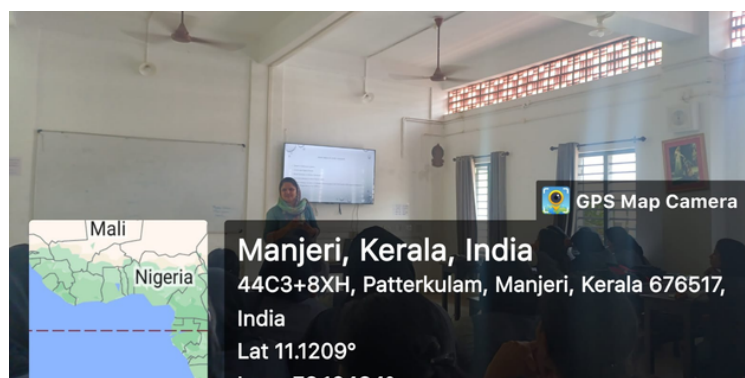
Work Readiness Programme

Field trip to IISR, Kozhikode and Kerala Vallikkunnu Community Reserve, Balathiruthi

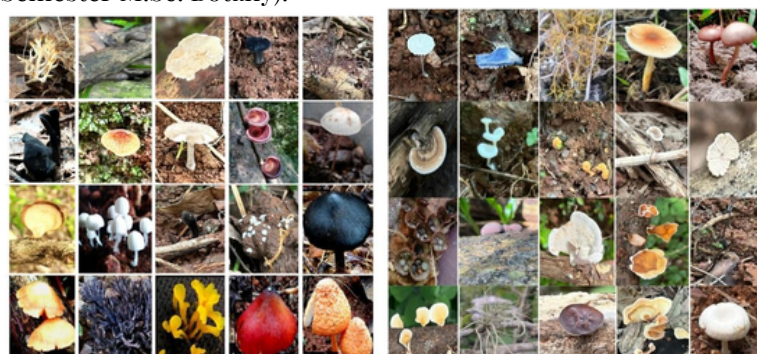
Postgraduate students from Department of Botany, KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, visited Indian Institute of Spices Research (ICAR - IISR), Kozhikode on 21/08/2023 FN. The aim of the visit was to enhance their understanding of plant pathology, molecular biology, plant biotechnology, and spice cultivation, with a particular focus on black pepper varieties. The students were exposed to cutting-edge research techniques such as DNA sequencing, genetic modification, PCR and Gel Doc techniques. The group visited the plant nursery and observed various stages of plant propagation and growth of pepper, nutmeg, vanilla, etc.

In the afternoon session they visited Kerala Vallikkunnu Community Reserve, Balathiruthi to observe ecologically sensitive mangroves and associated vegetation. Notable mangrove species like *Avicennia officinalis*, *Avicennia marina* and *Bruguiera cylindrica* were among those identified during their visit. These different species play crucial roles in the coastal ecosystem by providing habitats for various marine life, protecting shorelines from erosion, and contributing to overall environmental health. The field trip was coordinated by Dr. Faseela P (Assistant Professor), Ms. Shifa (Assistant Professor Adhoc) and Ms. Fayiza (3rd sem MSc Botany).



'Through Fungal Jungle of Unity Campus'

To observe the diversity of fungal species in the Campus of KAHM Unity Women's College, Manjeri, Biodiversity Club in association with PG Department of Botany organized an experiential walk 'Through Fungal Jungle of Unity Campus' on 14th August 2023. 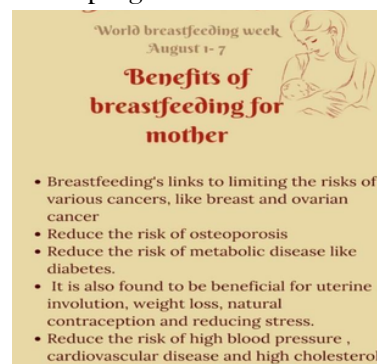


Department of Home Science

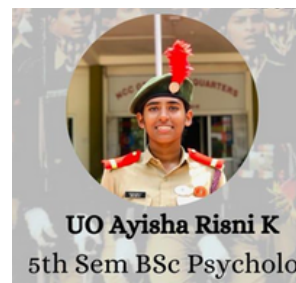
Palliative Care Dialysis Kit Packing

Student's Achievements

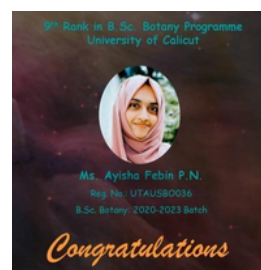

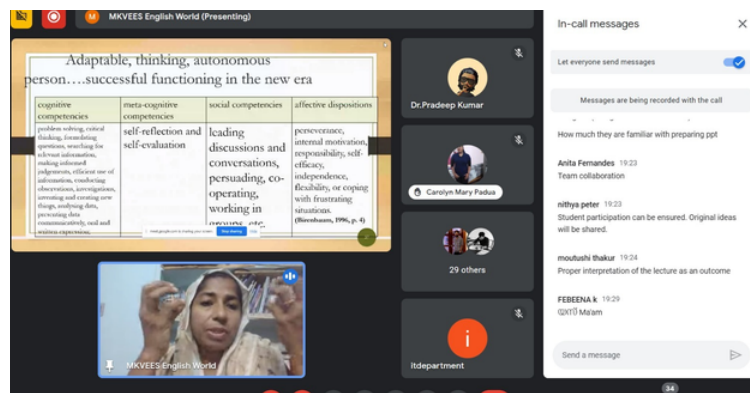
