## Department of History

# Substance Abuse Awareness Program Conducted by SEED Club

As part of the ongoing 'Thanichalla' project, the Mathrubhumi SEED Club at KAHM Unity Women's College, Narukara, organized a significant Substance Abuse Awareness Program on 30th August 2024 aimed at educating students on the critical issues surrounding drug and substance abuse. The program was inaugurated by College Principal, Prof. Mohammed Basheer Ummathur, who emphasized the importance of awareness in combating the rising concerns of substance abuse among youth. The event highlighted the college's commitment to fostering a safe and healthy environment for students. The main session was led by Vimukthi Mission District Coordinator, Ms. Ghadha M.S., who delivered an impactful awareness class on the severe health consequences and legal ramifications associated with drug and substance use. The session was both informative and engaging, encouraging students to think critically about the choices they make and the influence of peer pressure. The class provided practical insights into how students can protect themselves and others from the dangers of substance abuse, making it a valuable experience for all attendees. The program also included a felicitation ceremony, with speeches by Dr. Usman A., Head of the Department of Botany, and Ms. Abhirami, District SEED Coordinator. The event was coordinated by Dr. Faseela P., SEED club coordinator, and Sana V., Fifth Semester B.Sc. Botany.



# Growing Cowpeas: From Seed to Pod

On 9th August 2024, the department initiated a hands-on cowpea gardening project, aimed at providing a B.Sc. Botany students with practical experience in vegetable cultivation. The event marked the beginning of a season-long project, where students would actively engage in every stage of the gardening process, from seed sowing to harvest. This initiative is part of the department's ongoing efforts to integrate theoretical knowledge with practical skills, enhancing student's understanding of Plant Biology, Ecology and Sustainable Agriculture. At first, students prepared the soil in the designated Polyhouse area by clearing the weeds, rocks and other debris, and proceeded to till the soil, ensuring it was well-aerated and free from compaction. Compost is mixed into the soil to enhance fertility and improve soil structure, providing an ideal growing medium for pea plants. Following the soil preparation, the students moved on to the seed-sowing process. The faculties provided a demonstration of the correct planting depth and spacing for pea seeds. The seeds were sown at a depth of 1-2 inches, with a spacing of 2 inches between each seed, and 18-24 inches between rows. After sowing, the garden beds were lightly watered to settle the seeds into the soil and initiate the germination process. As peas are climbing plants, students were also involved in setting up support structures, and stakes. The pea gardening event, coordinated by Deepa P., Surya E.V. and Rahila was a resounding success, with students gaining valuable hands-on experience in the fundamental aspects of vegetable gardening.

On 16th August 2024, a Bridge Course, coordinated by Ms. Nadiya K.T. and Ms. Daliya T.P., was conducted for First-Semester M.Sc. Botany students. Dr. Usman A. welcomed the students, highlighting the department's achievements and ongoing projects. Dr. Faseela P. provided an overview of the M.Sc. curriculum, explaining the structure and importance of each module. Ms. Shifa M. introduced the lab facilities and good practices, while Ms. Nadiya K.T. discussed the career scope in Plant Science, including opportunities in research, conservation, agriculture, and biotechnology. Ms. Surya E.V. guided students in preparing for competitive exams like CSIR-NET and GATE. ## Workshop on ‘Skeleton Leaves Art’

Botany, guided the participants through the process of creating and decorating skeleton leaves. The workshop was attended by all Fifth Semester B.Sc. Botany students, who actively participated in the hands-on sessions. The event aimed to blend botanical science with creative artistry, offering students a unique opportunity to explore the aesthetic potential of plant materials. During the workshop, Ms. Safwa C.K. introduced the techniques of preparing skeleton leaves, a process that involves carefully removing the fleshy parts of the leaves to reveal their intricate vein structures. Once the skeletons were prepared, the participants engaged in painting and decorating the leaves, transforming them into delicate and beautiful pieces of art. She shared various tips and techniques to enhance the artistic quality of the leaves. The students, in turn, demonstrated great interest and creativity in their work, producing impressive results that reflected both their scientific knowledge and artistic talent. The workshop concluded with a display of the student's artworks, showcasing the diverse and imaginative ways in which the skeleton leaves were decorated. The event provided students with a deeper appreciation for the intersection of science and art, as well as practical skills that could be applied in both academic and creative pursuits.

## Nutribridge: Connecting Foundations to Future

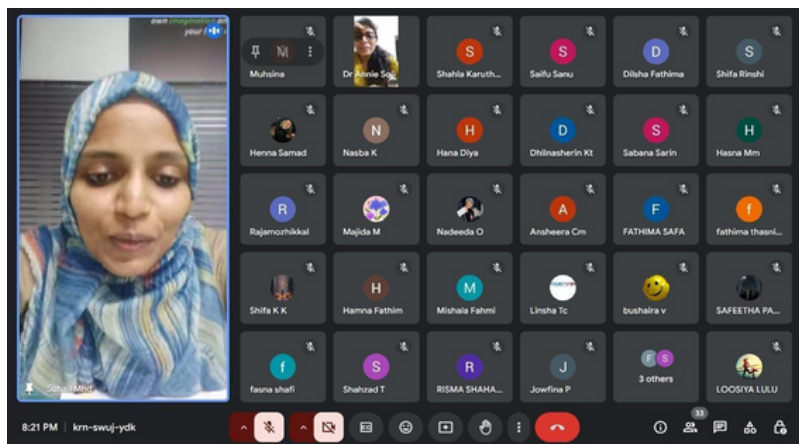

(Debate on Mullaperiyar Decommission)

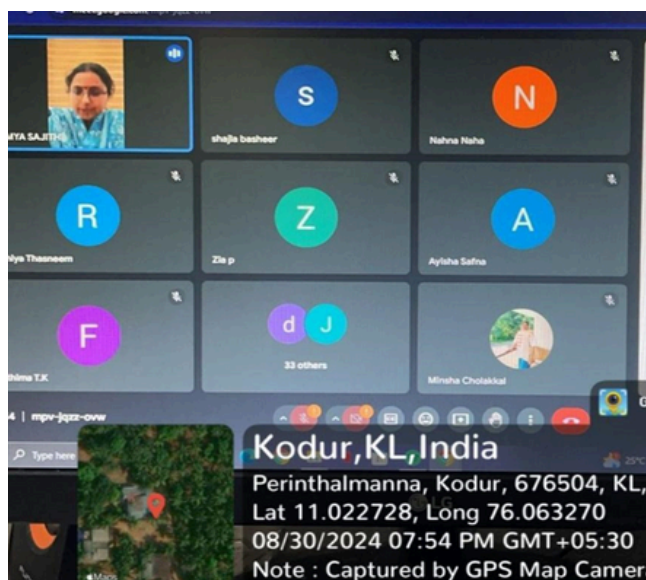

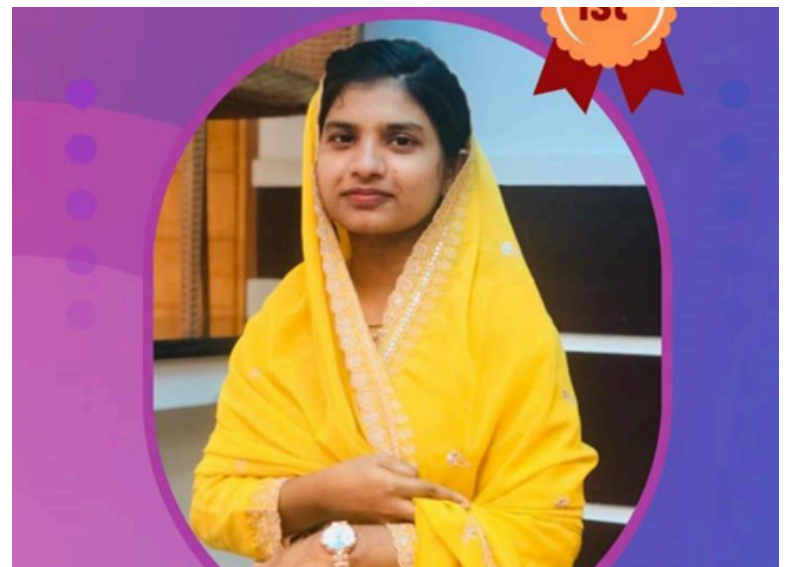
## Rebuilding a better Wayanad

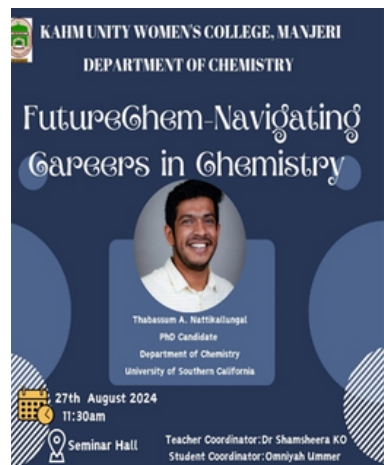
## International Day Against Nuclear Tests

## Hiroshima Day Celebration

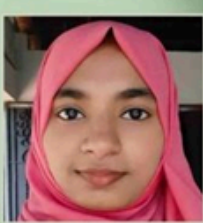
